# **Listening Comprehension**

### **Conversations**

# 1 题型介绍及答题策略

#### 听力对话

大学英语四级考试听力测试中含 10 道对话题。每个对话先由甲引出话题,再由乙对甲 所说的话作出反应。每个对话后提一个问题。试卷上有四个选项,其中一个为答案。

对话部分用于测试考生对简单的英语口语听的理解能力。每题的录音文字在 30 个词以内。

所提的问题有两类。第一类是事实题,第二类是推论题。两者的区别是,回答前一类问题时,考生根据所听内容直接回答问题;而回答后一类问题时,考生在听完对话后,需对听到的内容进行推论后才能答题。

例(1)

- M: If you mean to invite me to a meal, I'm free tonight.
- W: Good! I'll pick you up at your flat in twenty minutes.
- Q: Where does the woman invite the man to?
- A) To a dance.

C) To a concert.

B) To a dinner.

D) To a performance.

此题为事实题、出题点在 M 所说的"... invite me to a meal..."上。根据这部分内容即可找到答案(B)、因为其余三项都与"meal"无关。

例(2)

- M: Do you think we should invite Peter here for dinner?
- W: His mother is in hospital.
- Q: What does the woman mean?
- A) Peter is ill.

- C) Peter's mother is coming for dinner.
- B) Peter cannot come.
- D) Peter will come with his mother.

此题是较为典型的推论题,因为此题的出题点不在某一个词或句上,因此考生在答题时必须在听完对话作出推论后才能找到答案。根据这段对话,M提出是否邀请 Peter 吃饭,而W 并没有直接回答"是"或"否",而是说"Peter 的母亲住院了"。考生必须听懂 M 和 W 的话

才能推论出 B)"Peter cannot come"是答案。

在答这类题目时切不可仅凭一词半句选答案。例如,例(2)题中,有"ill","dinner", "mother"等词,如果考生仅根据这几个词来答题,很可能会选 A),C)或 D),因为在这三个选项中分别有"ill"(A),"dinner"(C)和"mother"(D)。

在大学英语听力考试的对话中,绝大多数为推论题。因此要提高这类题目的答对率就必须加强听力训练,切实提高英语听的能力,而不是靠猜测。
