

## 出版说明

本世纪四十年代后,随着语言理论和外语教学法的发展,英、美、澳等国先后出版了大量英语教材。这些教材在编写原则、词汇选择、课文设计、操练体系以及视听材料配套等方面都呈现了新的面貌,为非英语国家人民学习英语提供了更有科学性、系统性和易接受性的教学材料。由英国著名语言学家 L. G. Alexander 编著、英国朗曼公司出版的《新概念英语》(New Concept English)就是其中的一种。

新概念英语》共分四册:第一册《入门必读》(First Things First) 是入门读本:第二册《实践与提高》(Practice and Progress) 是向中级水平过渡的读本:第三册《技巧发展》(Developing Skills)为中级水平读本:第四册《流利英语》(Fluency in English)可达到初级英语证书的水平

本书作者 L. G. Alexander 一九八一年春在上海外国语 学院讲学时提出,外语教学要解决的两个根本问题是教什么和怎样教,这两者之间的相互作用即构成语言教学的核心。作者在编写《新概念英语》时就以这个原则为出发点。这套教材的特点是取材新颖、语言地道,课文剪裁合宜、短小精悍、含蓄幽默。本教材十分重视听说训练, L. G. Alexander 在教材的前言中提出上课的原则应该是"未听过的不说; 未说过的不读:未读过的不写。"正因为如此,教材于 1967 年出版后(第三册"Developing Skills"首版于 1964 年)为世界许多国家所采用,以后逐年重印, 历久不衰。

为适应我国广大读者的需要,我们特请上海外国语学院讲授这套 教材多年的英语教师翻译课文,提供必要的背景知识注释,并附有各 课练习答案,以供读者参考。
