

前 言

根据最新研究生英语入学考试大纲的要求,考生应"较熟练地掌握英语的基本语法和常用词汇,具有较强的阅读理解能力和一定的听说能力以及语言运用能力",本书则是为帮助考生达到这一目标而编写的。研究生英语入学考试分为6个部分,其中第一部分就是听力测试。听力测试要求考生从所听的内容中获取事实性的具体信息,理解明确表达或隐含其中的概念性含义,并进行判断、推理或引申,掌握说话者的意图、观点或态度。

听力测试占初试总分数的 20%,由 Part A、Part B和 Part C 三节(共 20 道题)组成:

Part A,根据一段独白或对话的内容做表格填空(共 5 题);

Part B,根据一段独白或对话的内容补全句子或做简答题(共5题);

Part C, 听三段独白或对话, 并分别根据所听到的内容做 多项选择题(共 10 题)。

为了实现教学和自学的有效性,编者特在 Part A和 Part B中各编写了两段独白或对话,而且有些相关练习中的题目数量超过了大纲规定的 5 题的要求,这都是为了使考生得到更多的训练,以便最终顺利地通过听力考试。另外,编者还提请考生注意:根据大纲要求,Part A和 Part B的材料考生应当听两遍,而 Part C的材料只能听一遍。

由于时间和能力所限,本书存在的不足和疏漏之处,恳请广大读者批评指正。
