

## INTRODUCTION

This list contains all common names approved by the Society for insects and other invertebrate animals commonly included in the field of entomology. It supersedes earlier lists sponsored by the Society and by the former American Association of Economic Entomologists. Names have been added and other changes made where required by action of the Committee and Society or by improved knowledge of taxonomy. Authors' surnames are given in full in accordance with a decision<sup>1</sup> announced earlier.

The Committee on Common Names of Insects has attempted to establish and maintain standards by which names proposed for addition to the approved list are to be accepted or rejected. Published recommendations<sup>2</sup> have served as general


guides for the present Committee. In 1953, A. B. Gurney reviewed the rules and recommendations concerning common names. His summary, somewhat modified, is presented here.

## RULES AND RECOMMENDATIONS

1. Included species will, in most cases, inhabit the United States, Canada, or their possessions and territories. In special cases, other species may be added.
2. The list is intended to include those insects and other invertebrates commonly of concern to entomologists because of their economic importance, striking appearance, abundant occurrence, or any other sufficient reason.
3. A common name should consist of three words or less, but four are permissible if reasons are sufficient.
4. Most names have two parts, one indicating the family or group, and the other a modifier. In the case of names having two parts, one of them a group name as given in Section IV, the group name will be a separate word when used in a sense that is systematically correct as in "house fly" and "bed bug." If the group name used is not systematically correct, it should be combined in a single word with a modifier as in the examples "citrus whitefly" and "citrus mealybug." The modifying part of the name should be based on some outstanding characteristic of the insect itself, its damage, host, or distribution. Hyphens between modifying words should be used only if the meaning is otherwise obscure.

### INTRODUCTION

This list contains all common names approved by the Society for insects and other invertebrate animals commonly included in the field of entomology. It supersedes earlier lists sponsored by the Society and by the former American Association of Economic Entomologists. Names have been added and other changes made where required by action of the Committee and Society or by improved knowledge of taxonomy. Authors' surnames are given in full in accordance with a decision<sup>1</sup> announced earlier.

4. Most names have two parts, one indicating the family or group, and the other a modifier. In the case of names having two parts, one of them a group name as given in Section IV, the group name will be a separate word when used in a sense that is systematically correct as in "house fly" and "bed bug." If the group name used is not systematically correct, it should be combined in a single word with a modifier as in the examples "citrus whitefly" and "citrus mealybug." The modifying part of the name should be based on some outstanding characteristic of the insect itself, its damage, host, or distribution. Hyphens between modifying words should be used only if the meaning is otherwise obscure.

5. The use of parts of the scientific name in the common name is undesirable unless the words involved are thoroughly established by usage as a common name.

6. Only in special cases should a species have more than one common name.

7. In the case of insects warranting special concern in both the larval and adult stages the name preferably should be one suggested by the appearance or habits of the more important or better known stage or the one for which usage has established the better name.

8. In all cases involving the adoption of new common names or changes in those previously established, the fullest consideration should be given to past usage and probable future usage. If practical, the considered opinions of entomologists experienced with the insects concerned should be obtained before names are proposed. Members who wish to recommend new names or changes in existing names should accept the responsibility for making the necessary investigation. All available evidence, both for and against, on the appropriateness of and need for each proposed name should accompany the proposal when it is submitted to the Committee Chairman.

## COMMITTEE PROCEDURES

Following receipt of a proposal, the Committee considers the evidence and votes on the case. Proposals receiving Committee approval (at least seven of the nine members of the Committee must approve) are published in the Bulletin of the Entomological Society of America. Any Society member disapproving a proposal may submit objections and evidence opposing the proposal to the Committee in the 30-day period after publication. If substantial objections to a proposal are received, the Committee reconsiders the case and makes a final decision.

Notice of final adoption or rejection of the proposal is then published in a later Bulletin of the Entomological Society of America. The essential features of the foregoing procedures are provided for by the By-Laws of the Society.

The scientific names of this list have been checked by taxonomists in the Systematic Entomology Laboratory, Insect Identification and Beneficial Insect Introduction Institute, U.S. Department of Agriculture, and the Department of Entomology, U.S. National Museum of Natural History, Smithsonian Institution, except those in a few restricted groups on which collaborators have been consulted. The scientific names shown are those said to be in current use.

## ARRANGEMENT OF NAMES

The common names list is maintained in computerized form by Jerry Odland of the ESA staff. This list is periodically updated, and is used to generate the printed format, only diacritical marks having to be added manually. The basic list is manipulated to generate Sections I-III. The arrangement of Section IV follows Section IV of the 1978 revision, with a few additions to accommodate new entries into the main list, and some changes to conform with current systematic usage at the family level. Orders and Families are arranged alphabetically under the appropriate Class.
