出版说明

丛书共80册,分3、5、7、9四级,其中3级10册,5级20册,7级20册,9级30册。本丛书与"外教社·朗文小学英语分级阅读"一脉相承,是外教社与朗文合作推出的阅读精品。

作为以《新课标》为指导编写课外阅读的积极尝试,我们衷心希望广大读者能够多与我们联系、沟通,提出宝贵的意见和建议,协助我们精益求精,将丛书不断提高、完善。
