PREFACE TO THE SEVENTH EDITION

THIS edition contains new chapters on the Crown Court, on Family Law and on Evidence and Civil Procedure; and the opportunity has been taken to revise, clarify and correct the text throughout.

Recent statutes of which account has been taken include the European Communities Act 1972, which makes Community law a source of English law and provides for applications from English courts to the European Court of Justice for preliminary rulings; the Criminal Law Act 1977, reorganising the distribution of work between magistrates' courts and the Crown Court, and reducing the functions of coroners' courts; the Administration of Justice Act 1977, dealing with such miscellaneous matters as legal aid, appeals, county courts and abolition of the jurisdiction of many ancient courts; legislation further extending the jurisdiction of county courts; the Employment Protection Act 1975, creating the Employment Appeal Tribunal; the Powers of Criminal Courts Act 1973; the Torts (Interference with Goods) Act 1977, which gives the generic name of wrongful interference to conversion, trespass and negligent harm to goods; and the Inheritance (Provision for Family and Dependents) Act 1975.

Attention is drawn to a number of recent cases, notably on the interpretation of statutes and judicial precedent. The High Court in the provinces, arbitration, prospective overruling, criminal proceedings and agency have been given new or fuller treatment. The setting up or reports of various commissions and committees have been mentioned, including the Royal Commission on Legal Services, the Royal Commission on Civil Liability and Personal Injury (Pearson), the Faulks Committee on Defamation and the Law Commission's latest reports and working papers.

Although we severally undertook the preparatory work on particular chapters we are jointly responsible for the whole edition, except that the publishers have once more revised the Tables of Cases and Statutes and the Index.

EXTRACT FROM
PREFACE TO THE FIRST EDITION

THIS book is intended as an elementary introduction for those about to embark, for whatever purpose, on the study of English law. Following a brief survey of the characteristics of English law and the principles on which justice is administered in this country, an account is given in Part I of the various systems of courts, their composition and jurisdiction, with just enough history to indicate their origins. Apart from other considerations, some knowledge of the jurisdiction of the courts is necessary for an appreciation of the authority of their decisions at the present day, as well as the part they have played in the development of various branches of law in the past.

Part II deals relatively fully with the sources of English law, a topic with which the student of law needs to be acquainted at the outset, although in some University degree courses he has to wait for formal instruction in these matters until he reads Jurisprudence in his third year. I have tried . . . not only to explain the principles underlying the interpretation of statutes, the application of judicial precedent and the use of legal textbooks, but also to describe the literary materials in which legislation, judicial decisions and juristic opinion are embodied, so that the reader may enter a law library without fear and find what he wants without groping.

Part III sketches in outline the main branches of English private law. . . . Only the most general principles can be stated in the space available, the object being to introduce the reader to legal conceptions and terminology. This part is therefore highly selective, though I hope not too dogmatic. . . .
