

### 前言

对于广大英语学习者说来,听懂英语是一件令人头痛的事情, 因为大多数人缺少这方面的训练。然而,现在各种形式、各种级别 的考试都要加试听力。在大学英语四、六级考试中,听力测试安排 在试卷的第一部分,这一部分考得好坏,直接影响考生的考试情 绪。因此,提高听力水平是十分关键的。

本书的编写者们都是长期从事大学英语教学,富有经验的教师。他们对历年四、六级考试作了大量的分析,对听力部分的考点逐一作了研究,结合广大同学在日常学习中存在的问题,将听力测试的内容分为不同的类型,有针对性地进行分类训练。其好处在于可以帮助学生们在最短的时间内理清思路,对每一类型的测试点进行有的放失的强化训练,以收到事半功倍的效果。在分类训练之后,随即转入考前实战的训练,将在分类训练中所获得的技能立即转变成为适应考试实际要求的能力,从而树立起坚强的自信心。
