Preface

This second Supplement to the ninth edition of the Guide to Reference Books lists nearly 2,100 items, most of them published during the 1978-80 period. Items with 1977 publication dates received too late for inclusion in the 1980 Supplement were given full consideration, as were older works which had previously escaped the compilers' attention. Although the cut-off date for this Supplement was December 1980, a few 1981 publications have been included. In most sections we continued to add newly received 1980 publications through the end of July 1981, but are well aware that some 1980 imprints worthy of inclusion were simply not available for examination before the work of compilation was completed. In the matter of recording new volumes or parts of works listed as "in progress" in the Guide and its earlier Supplement, we included whatever parts had been received by Spring of 1981 and sometimes later.

No attempt was made to assign "quotas" to the individual sections or to balance the number of items in a given section of this *Supplement* against that in the corresponding section of the 1980 volume. Rather, we have intended to make inclusion a matter of merit. General usefulness and quality of the work remained the principal criteria for inclusion, with exceptions regularly made for works of less than top quality which fill a definite gap. Although we have tried to keep the

needs of the small and medium-sized library very much in mind, there is a continued emphasis on scholarly works, some of them being of a fairly specialized nature.

Arrangement of entries corresponds to that employed in the ninth edition of the *Guide* and its earlier *Supplement*, with occasional inclusion of a new subdivision or, in the interest of saving space, combining or eliminating certain subheads.

With few exceptions, form of entry corresponds to that found on Library of Congress printed cards or in MARC records; CIP information was accepted if later Library of Congress cataloging was not available at the time our typescript was prepared. In a few instances series entries have been employed in the interest of saving space, even though Library of Congress cataloging provides a separate entry for each item in the series.

Library of Congress class marks have been included when available. As before, call numbers are usually those found on Library of Congress cards or in MARC records, although here, too, CIP information was accepted when other records were not available. Class marks "locally" assigned to items for which Library of Congress cataloging information was not available have not been included. In the previous Supplement call numbers for continuations of those items noted as

"in progress" in the *Guide* were not repeated. Contrary to that practice, we have here provided Library of Congress class marks for all entries as available, whether the work is new to this *Supplement* or represents an additional volume of a work previously recorded in the *Guide* or its first *Supplement*. Dates at the end of class marks are usually omitted.

As in the earlier Supplement, prices have been given when available—usually in the currency of the country of publication, but in some instances only in United States dollars. It should be kept in mind that price information comes from a wide range of sources—in-print catalogs, publishers' announcements, catalog records, etc.—and may not always reflect the latest price. Although we have done our best to provide current and accurate prices, the figures given should be taken as an indication of the price range rather than the exact cost.

To avoid repetition of information appearing in the ninth edition of the *Guide* and its first *Supplement*, cross references to those volumes have been liberally employed. Item numbers in this *Supplement* carry the prefix "2" to distinguish them from items in the earlier *Supplement*. Thus, a typical reference to the first *Supplement* will read "For 2d ed. see *Suppl.* BB35" whereas one to an item within the present volume reads "For full information see *Suppl.* 2AA31."

The "division of labor" for this compilation was much the same as that for the previous Supplement to the ninth edition of the Guide. That is, Rita Keckeissen again had major responsibility for the Language Dictionaries, Genealogy, and Religion sections, and Eileen McIlvaine was again mainly responsible for the Fine Arts, Music, and History and Area Studies sections. Both of them did masses of proofreading at all stages, helped unravel bibliographic snarls, rounded up elusive bits of information, served as sounding boards in matters of policy and arrangement of entries, and assisted with the preparation of the index. Diane Goon again accepted responsibility for most of the work on the Social Sciences section; her contribution is a model of thoroughness. Work

All other sections and the general editorship of this *Supplement* have been the responsibility of the undersigned, but without the dedication and aid of those just named, the work could not have been completed.

Once again it is a pleasure to acknowledge the help and encouragement of colleagues at the Columbia University Libraries and throughout the New York metropolitan area-in particular, those at the New York Public Library (including the Midmanhattan and Lincoln Center divisions), Union Theological Seminary Library, and New York University Library. The list of individual names of persons who gave assistance would be a very long one, but special mention should be made of the contribution of Ryoko Toyama of Columbia's East Asian Library for her careful review and updating of the entries relating to Japan. The cooperation of numerous publishers is also much appreciated; although review copies are rarely solicited for the Guide, the willingness of publishers to make such copies available (either on request or at their own initiative) has been very gratifying.

Final words of thanks are again reserved for the loyal and cooperative staff members of the Reference Departments of Columbia University's Butler and Lehman libraries: Laura Binkowski, Paul Cohen, Anita Lowry, Mary Ann Miller, and part-time assistants Deborah Bezanson and Carol Briggs. They all have my deep gratitude. Being able to rely on such a steady and conscientious staff is a prime factor in maintaining the Guide as a Columbia-based compilation.

The great advantage of this set is the cumulative aspect which obviates the need to consult supplements as well as the basic volumes, but libraries owning the earlier sets will need to weigh frequency of use against the very considerable cost of the cumulation. An early review in the *Times Literary Supplement* (Apr. 4, 1980, p.398) mentions that a "D" prefixed to a shelfmark indicates that the book was destroyed during World War II, although this is not explained in the preface.

Includes books, periodicals (together with some indexing of contents of periodicals), and other media in most fields of human knowledge—one of the world's great collections.

"The major part of the collections is represented . . . , including materials for general research, history and the humanities, the social sciences, science and technology, history of the Americas, local history and genealogy, art and architecture, and rare books. It includes entries for parts of the collections of music, dance, theatre, Orientalia, Baltica, Slavonica, and Judaica. It does not include certain forms of material such as manuscripts, maps, prints, etc."—p.xxiii.

The completed catalog will offer photographic reproduction of about nine million catalog cards in some 800 volumes.

The *Dictionary catalog*, which began publication in 1972 (*Guide* AA112), suspended publication after the July 1981 supplement.

The annual volumes constitute a cumulation of materials from several sources, the cumulation pattern and contents varying slightly. The current pattern is as follows: a weekly alphabetical list appears in the periodical *Det danske Bogmarked*. Separately published monthly lists entitled *Dansk Bogfortegnelse* (containing a classified short-title list in addition to the alphabetical section) appear 12 times a year, every third issue constituting a quarterly cumulation. Annual cumulations (the *Ārskatalog*) include the alphabetical and classified sections plus a Faroese book list, a Greenlandic book list, and a section of maps. The annuals will continue to cumulate quinquennially. A microfiche edition, cumulated from 1976, is also available, but does not include the special lists.
