One way to detect parents' influence in people is to look at age. Perrett's team presented male and female student with computer-generated (经过计算机处理的) images of average faces of the opposite sex at different stages of life and asked them to rate each face in terms of attractiveness. The students were also asked to answer questions about their parents — including their parents' ages.

What Perrett found was students who were born when their parents were older than 30 overwhelmingly (绝大多数) preferred older faces. Students whose parents were younger when they were born selected younger faces as more attractive. Those with older parents, Perrett said, "were less impressed by youth."

Perrett's colleague Anthony Little, also of St. Andrews University, has since followed up with another study looking at hair and eye color. His results show that people generally prefer faces with the same eye and hair color as their parent of the opposite sex (as in a woman's father or a man's mother).

One way to more accurately test whether our parents' looks influence our attraction to others would be to test adopted children to learn if they preferred features in their adopted or birth parents. Perrett says this could offer more definitive (最后的,决定性的) results, but he hasn't yet been able to do such extensive tests.

## Task 2

**Directions:** *This task is the same as Task 1. The 5 questions are numbered 41 through 45.*

The Graduate Record Examinations (GRE<sup>®</sup>) General Test is an admission test for applicants to graduate schools. Under the administration (管理, 经营) of the Educational Testing Service(ETS), the test is sponsored by the Graduate Record Examinations Board. The GRE<sup>®</sup> is a computer-adaptive test (CAT), and consists of three scored sections; One 30-minute, 30-question "Verbal Ability" (vocabulary and reading) section; One 45-minute, 28-question "Quantitative Ability" (math) section; One 60-minute, 35-question "Analytical Ability" (games and arguments) section. In addition, there may be a marketing survey, or one or two experimental sections, which can be Verbal, Quantitative, or Analytical.

As of October 2002, the "Analytical Ability" section will be replaced with an Analytical Writing Assessment (AWA). The AWA will be virtually identical to the GRE<sup>®</sup> Writing Assessment Test, which is currently given separately from the GRE<sup>®</sup> General Test. The AWA will consist of two writing tasks: a 45-minute essay in which you present your viewpoint on a particular issue; and a 30-minute essay in which you analyze an argument.

Each of the three sections is scored on a scale of 200 to 800. The average scores for the GRE<sup>®</sup> are about 470 for Verbal, 570 for Quantitative, and 540 for Analytical.

Schools vary tremendously in the weights they place on the different factors in the admission process, so be sure to contact the specific schools to which you are applying in order to determine their unique requirements. Some programs weight GRE<sup>®</sup> scores very heavily, and/or have a minimum score for applicants, while other programs consider GRE scores more of a formality (形式). It is important to note that your GRE<sup>®</sup> scores are a major factor in determining your eligibility (适合; 资格) for financial aid.

Described as a 'barren rock' 150 years ago, Hong Kong has since grown into a world-class financial, trading and business center. It is the world's 9th largest trading economy. Hong Kong advocates and practices free trade. Its taxes are low and simple. Its economy is backed by a government policy of maximum support and minimum interference. Hong Kong is used by multi-national companies as a regional base to manage their businesses in the Asia Pacific. This is reflected in Hong Kong's trade with the region, which grew at an average annual rate of 16% since 1980 and reached US\$ 233 billion in 1999.

Hong Kong has a trusted legal system and an independent judiciary (司法体制), which ensures that the rule of law is supported and that no one is above the law. Hong Kong became a Special Administrative Region of the People's Republic of China on 1 July 1997, after a century and a half of British administration. Under Hong Kong's constitutional (宪法的) document the Basic Law, the existing economic, legal and social systems will be maintained for at least 50 years after 1997.
