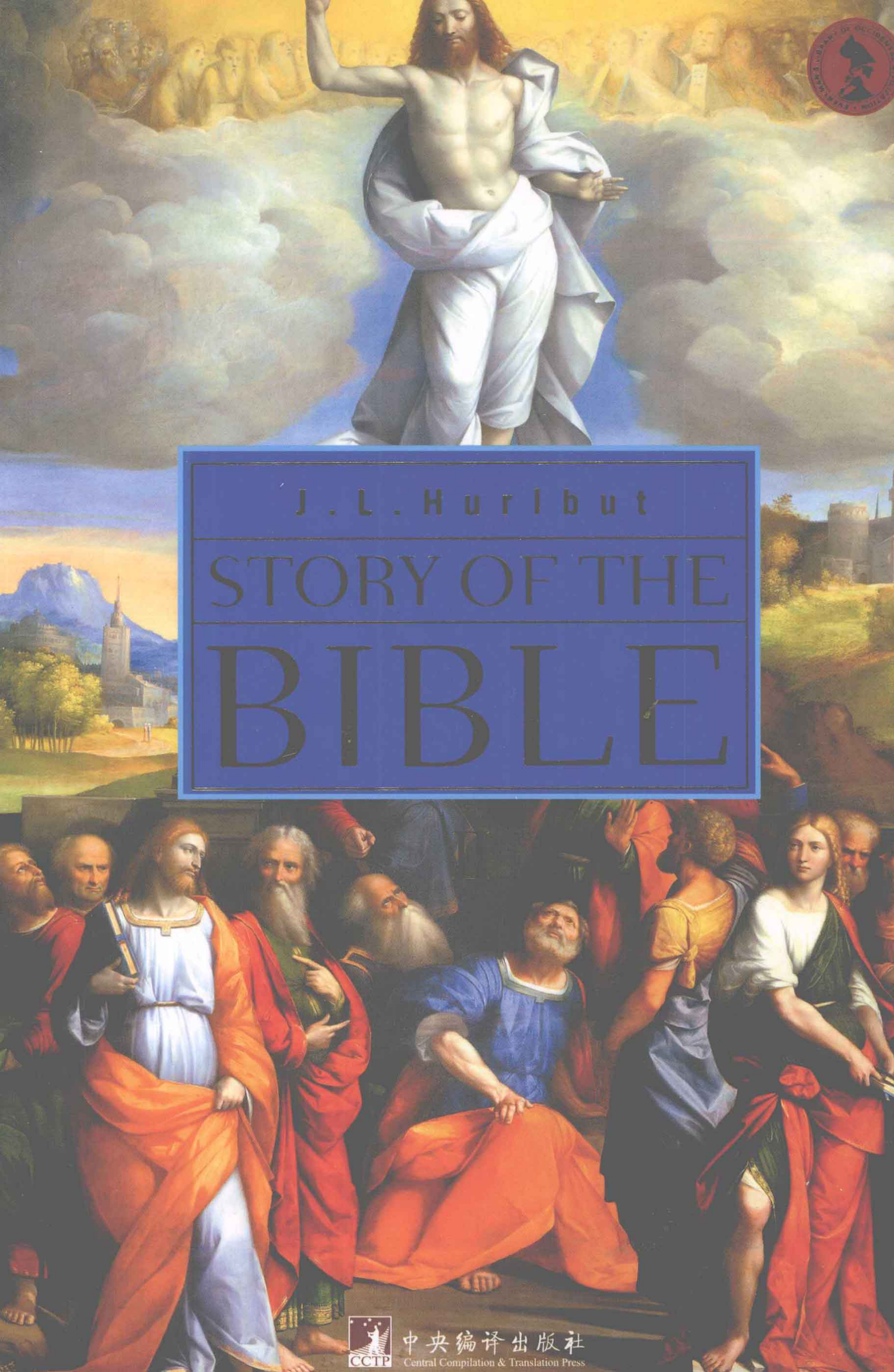

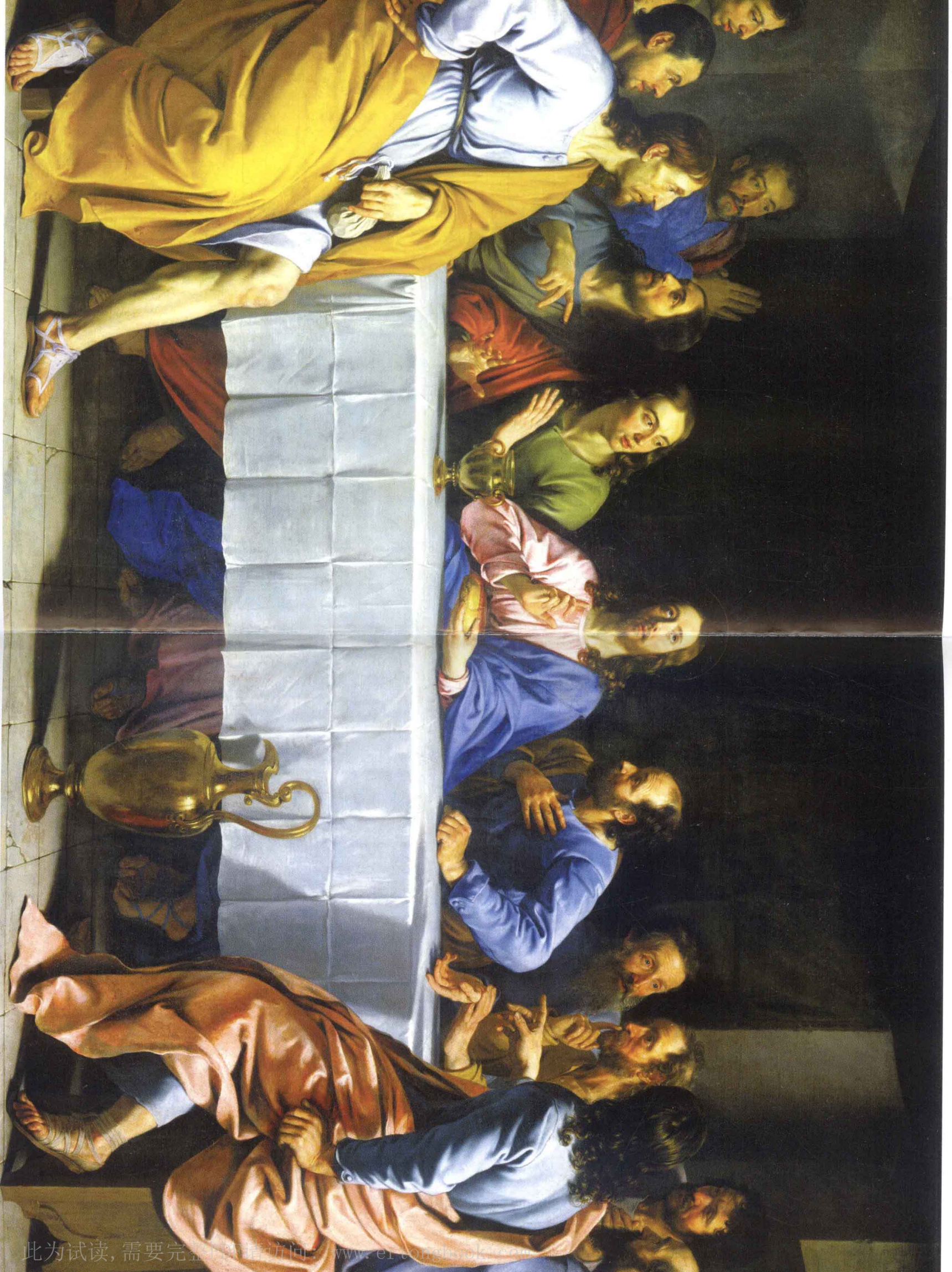


Fig. 7 The Last Supper by Philippe de Champaigne (1602-1674), a Baroque era painter of the French school.

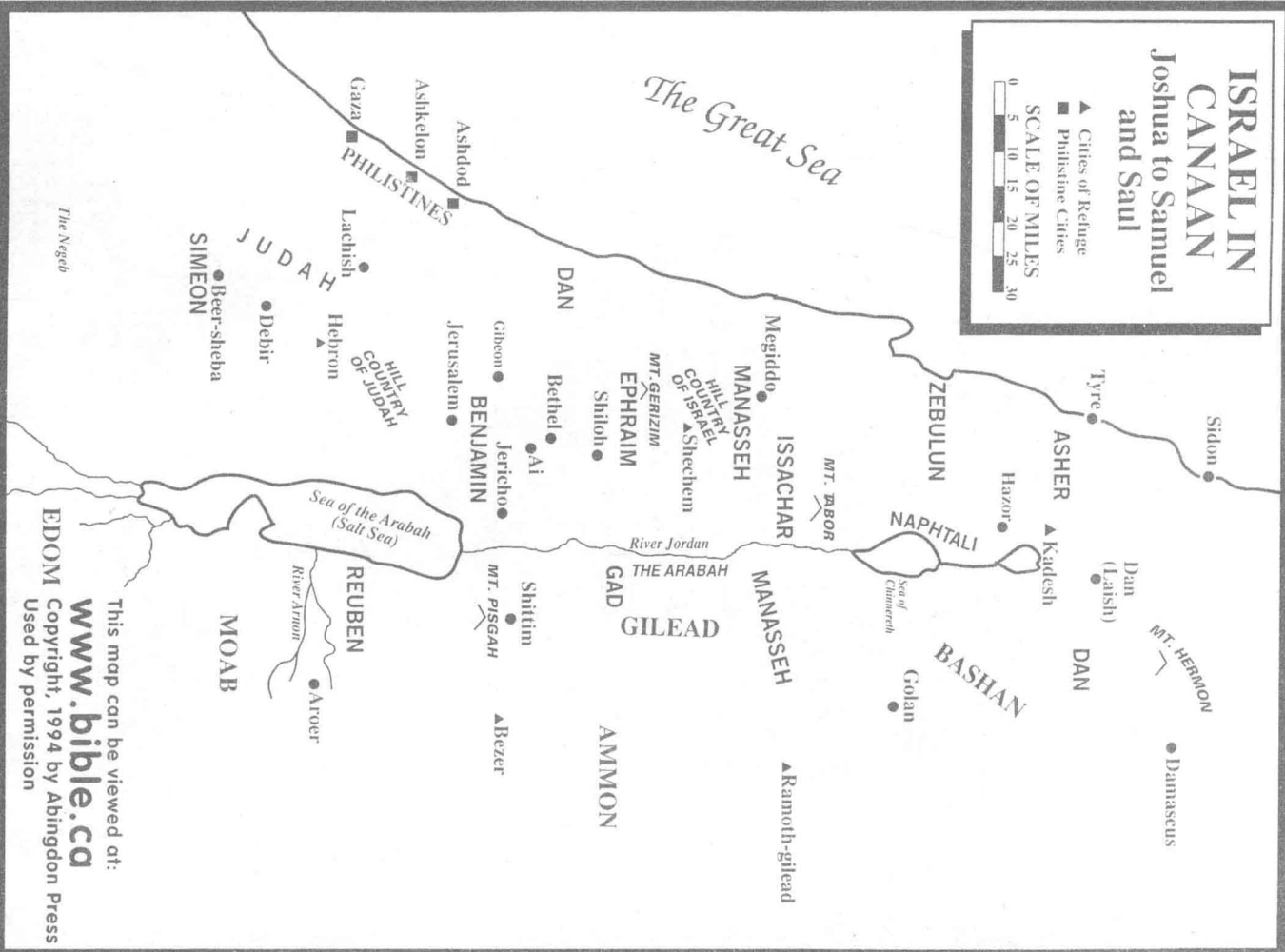


Fig.5 Orthodox Bulgarian icon of Constantine and St.Helena.

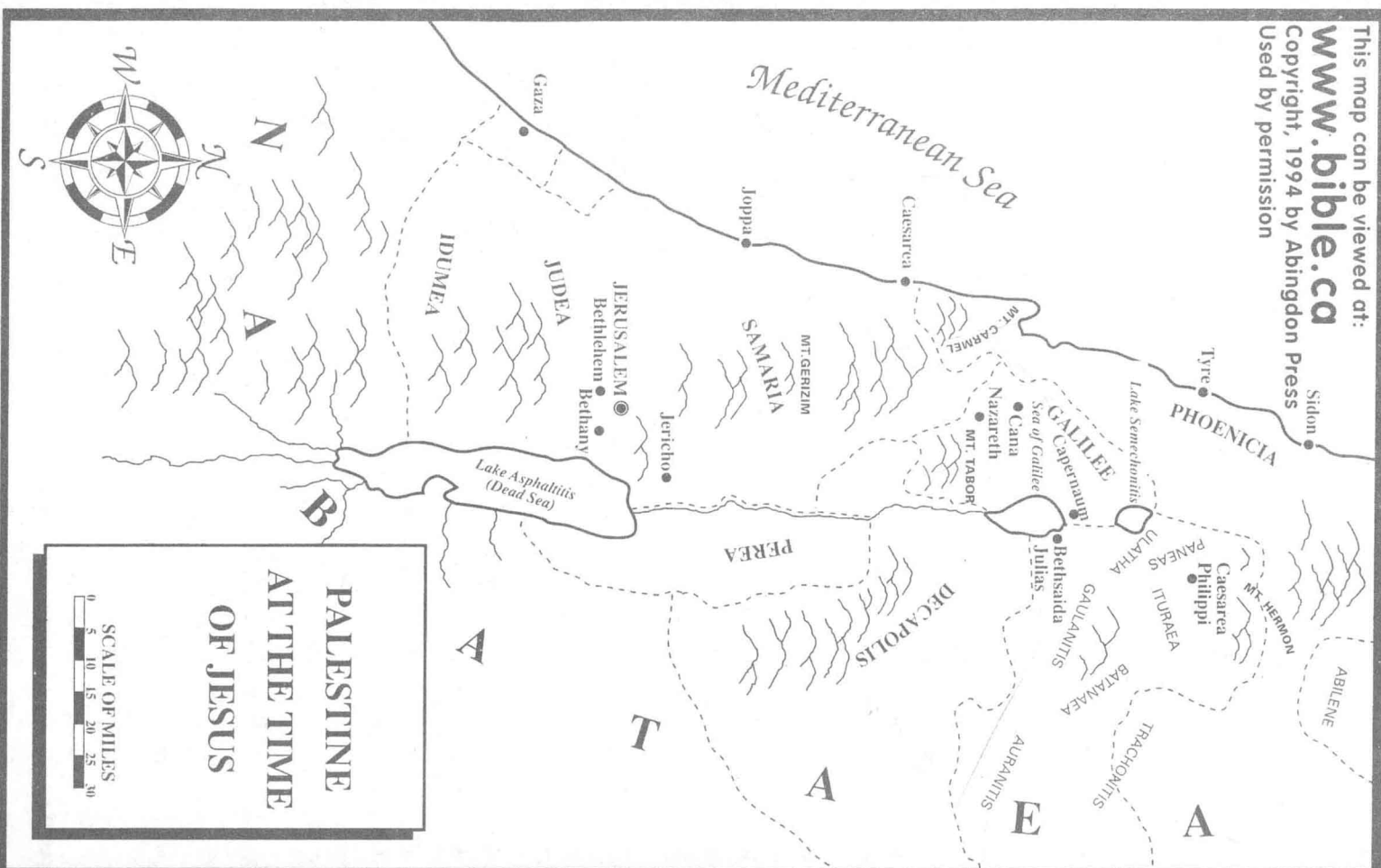

Map2 Palestine at the time of Jesus, 33AD.



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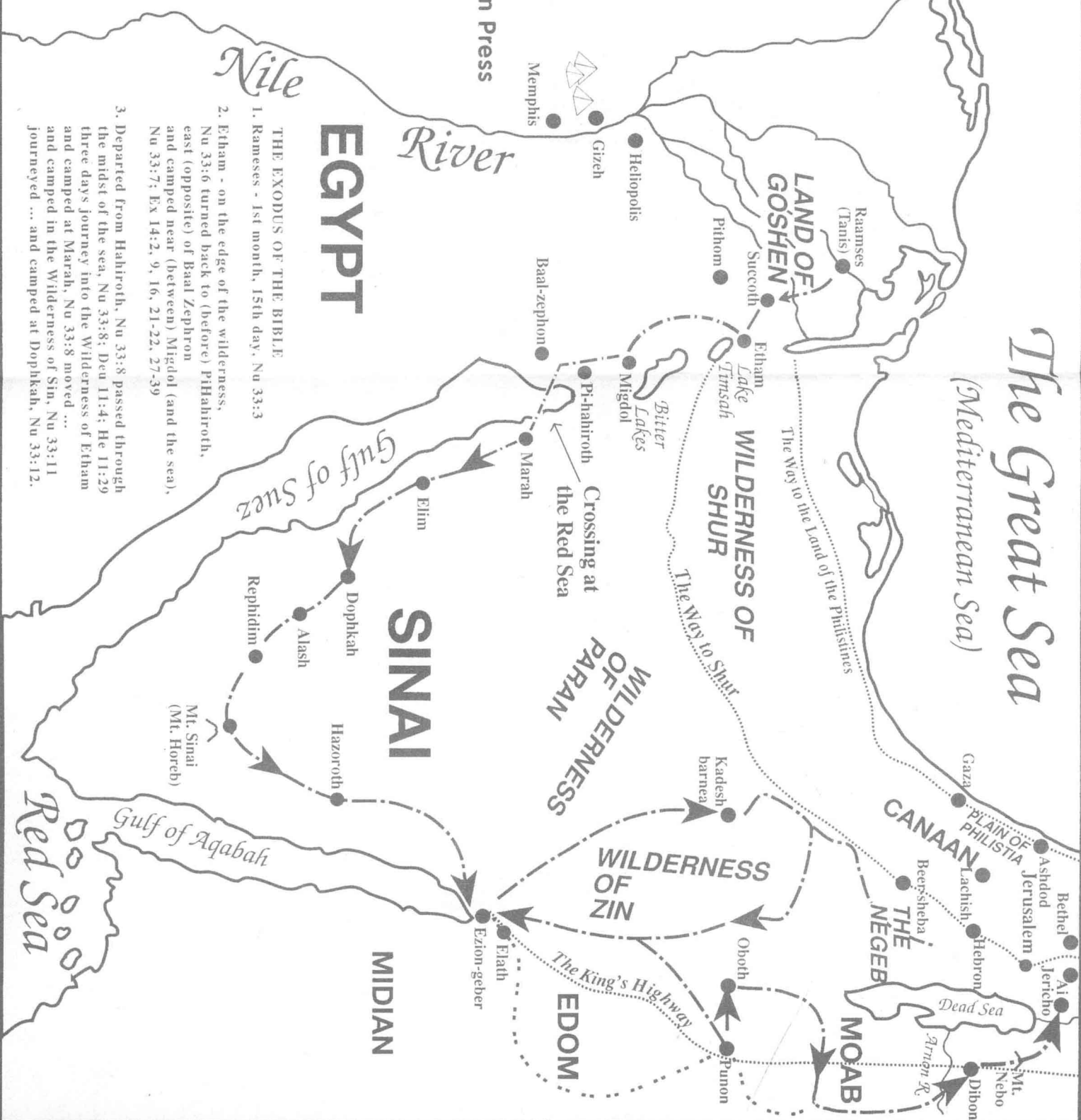

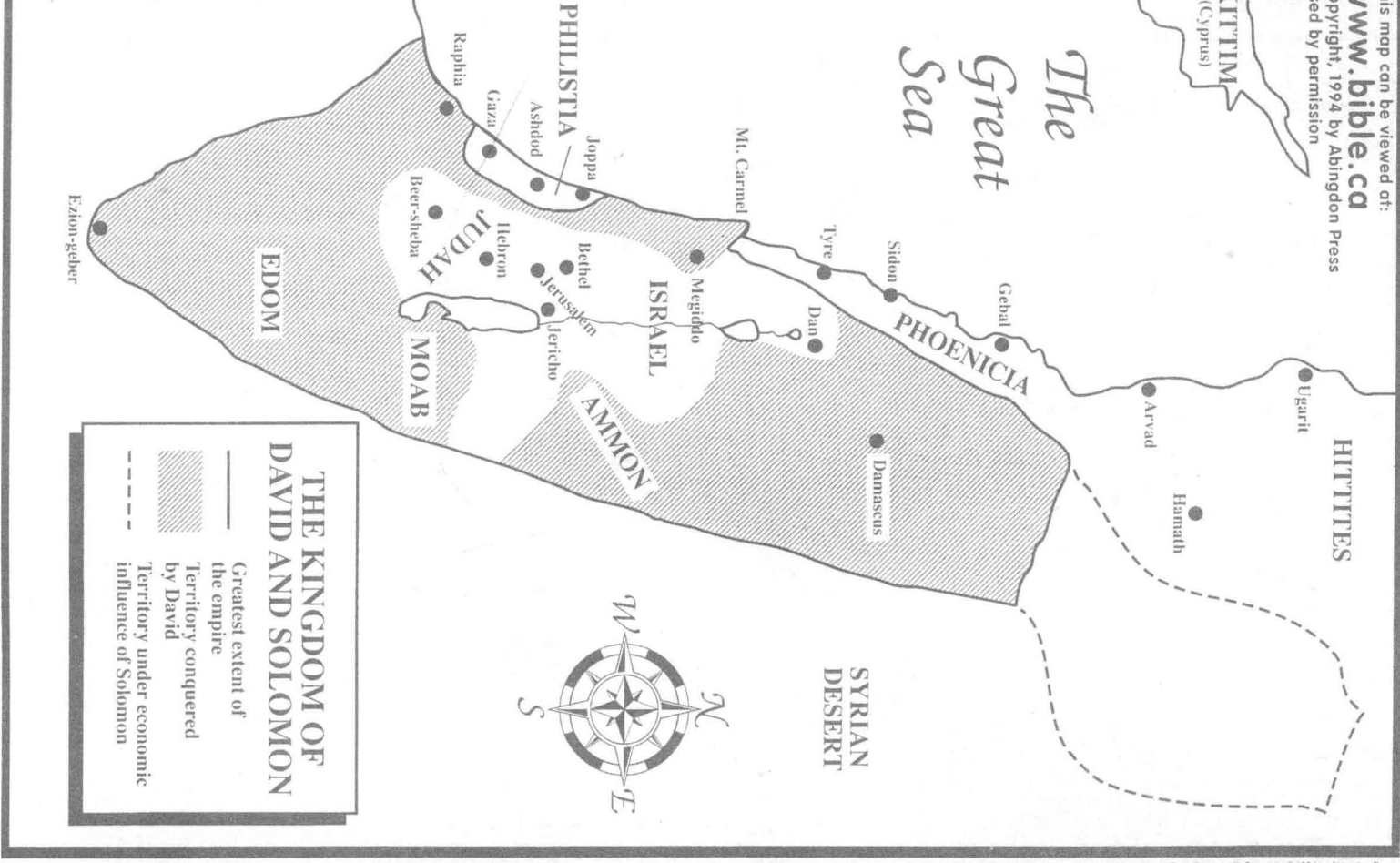
Traditional Route of the

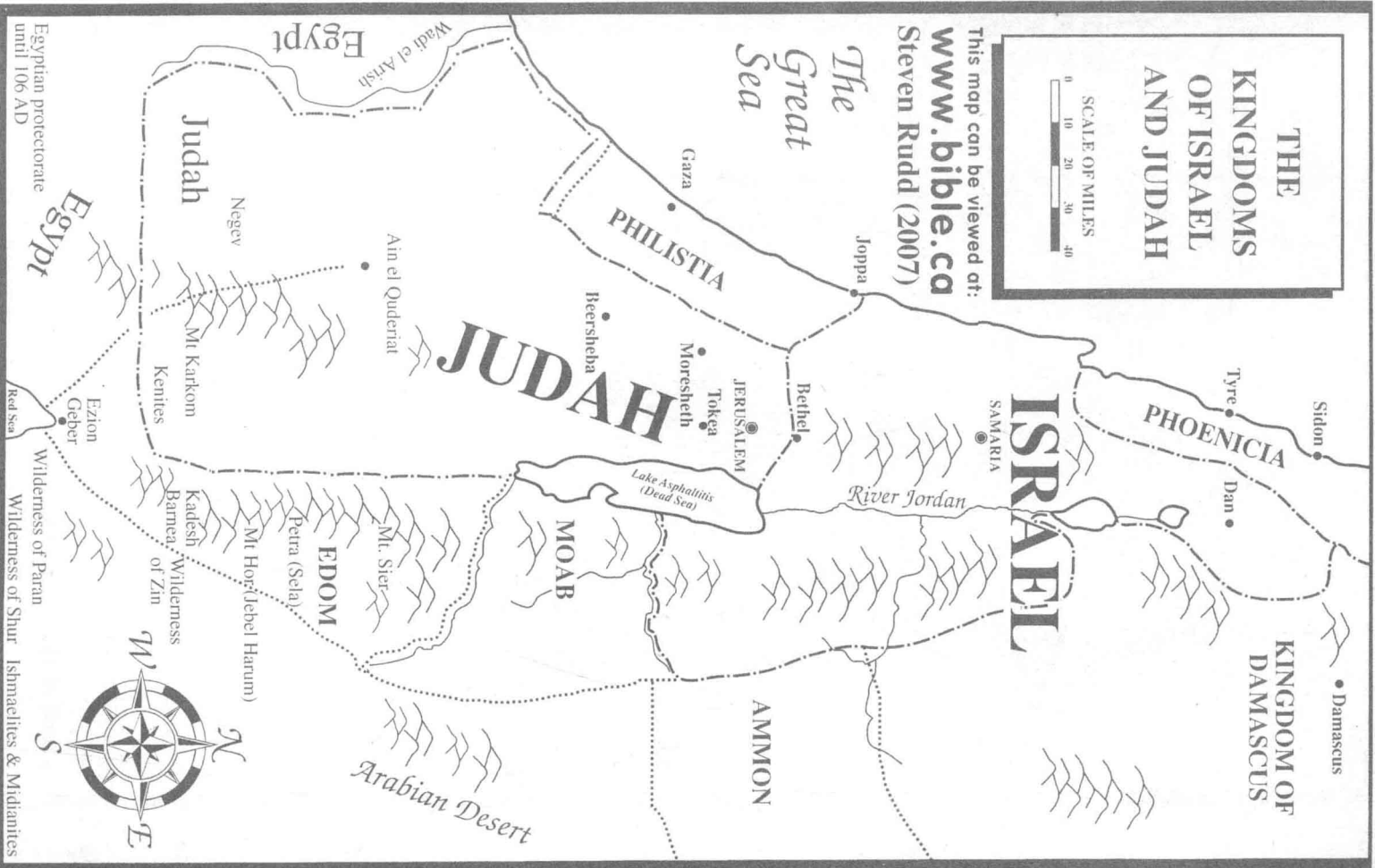

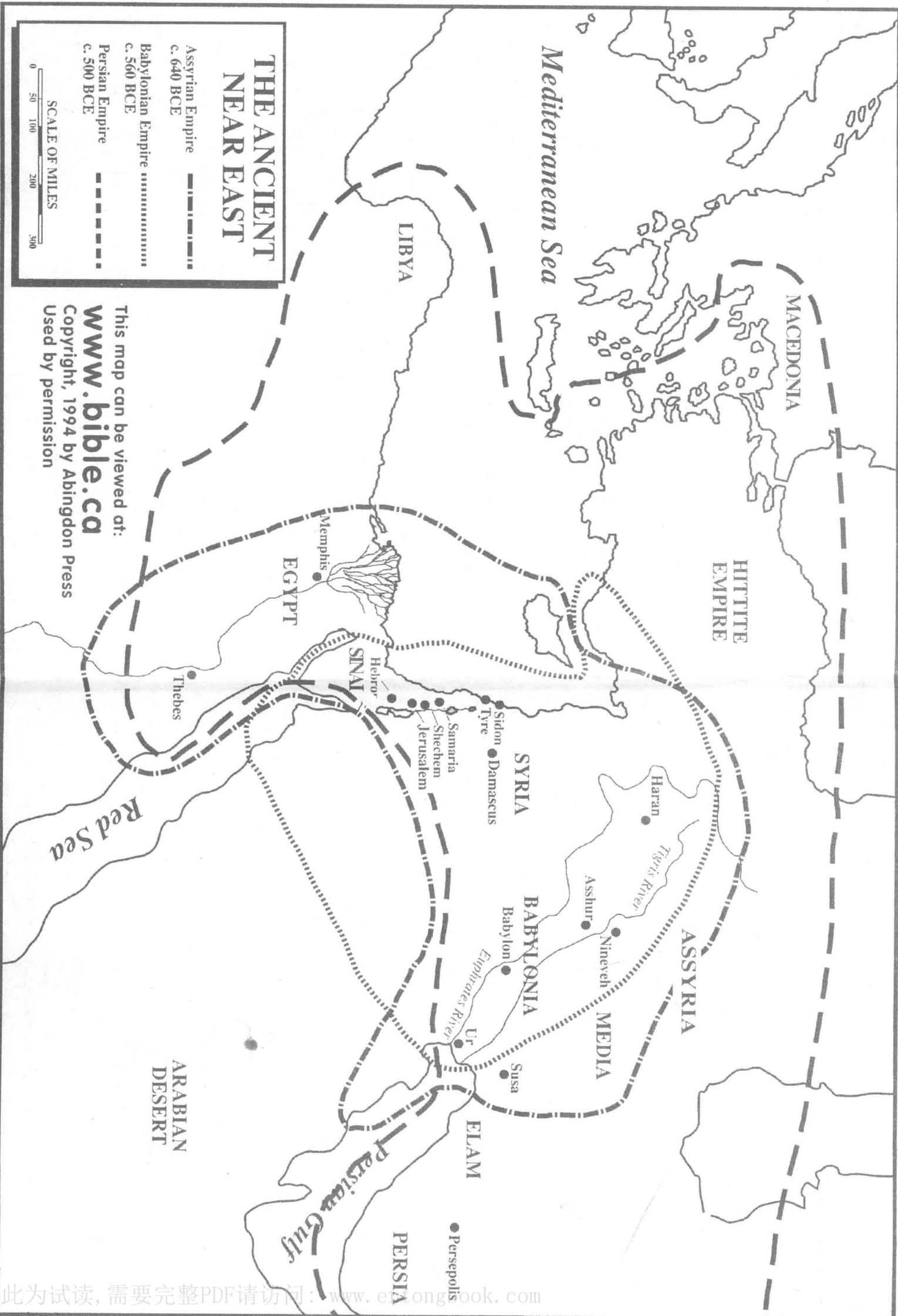
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Map5 The United Kingdoms of David and Solomon, 1000 BC.



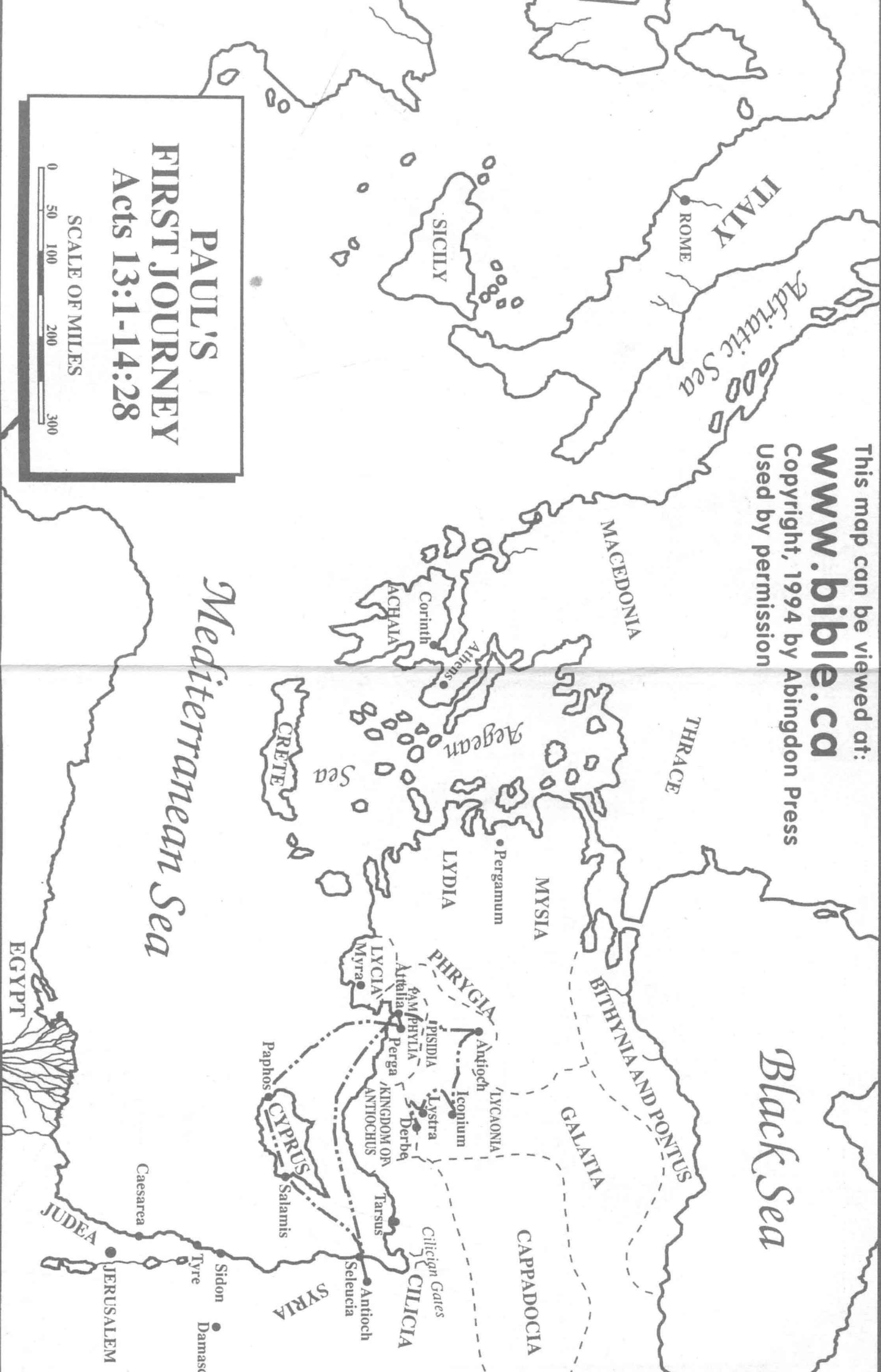
Map6 The Divided Kingdoms, 900-722 BC.



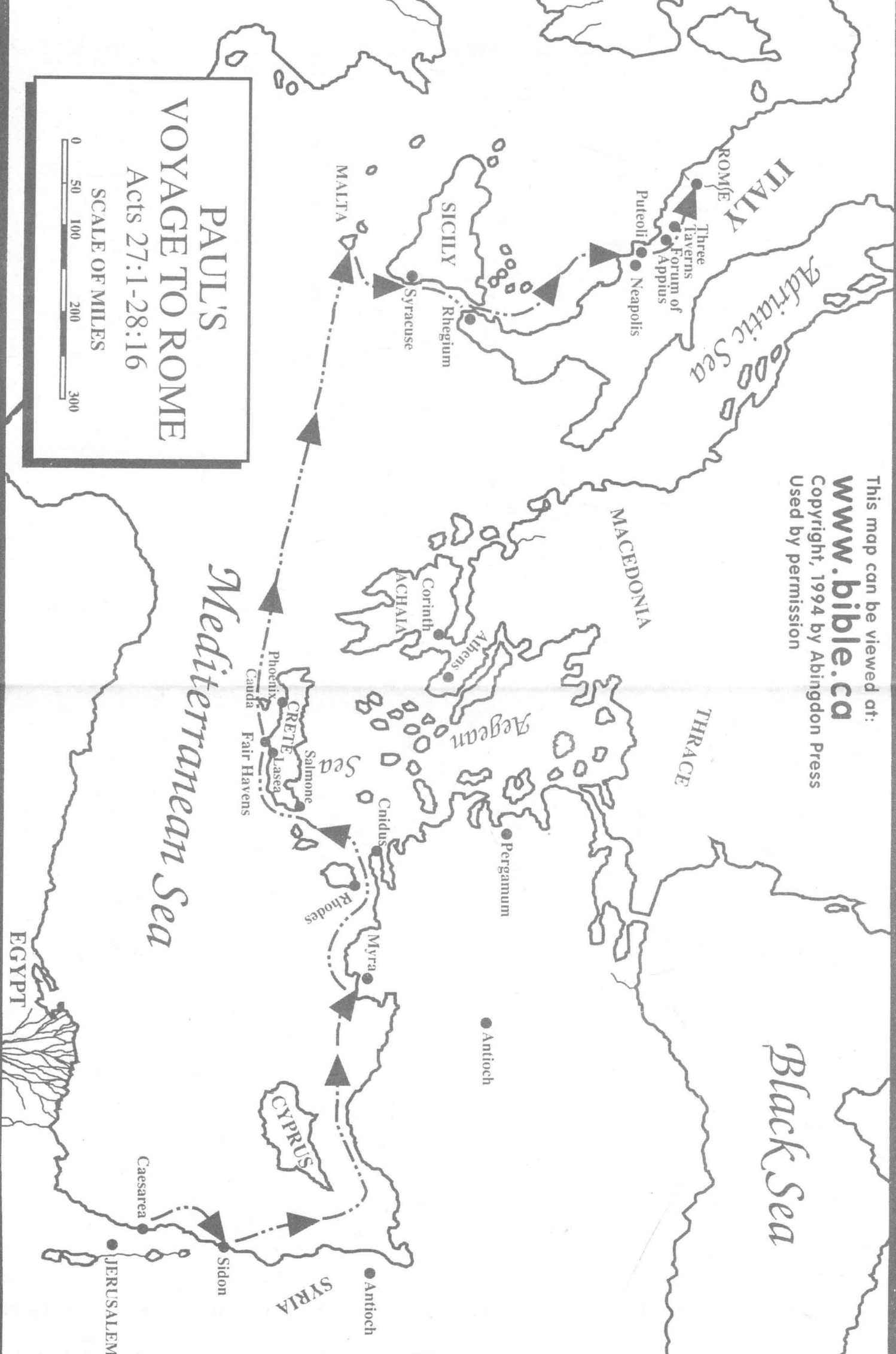

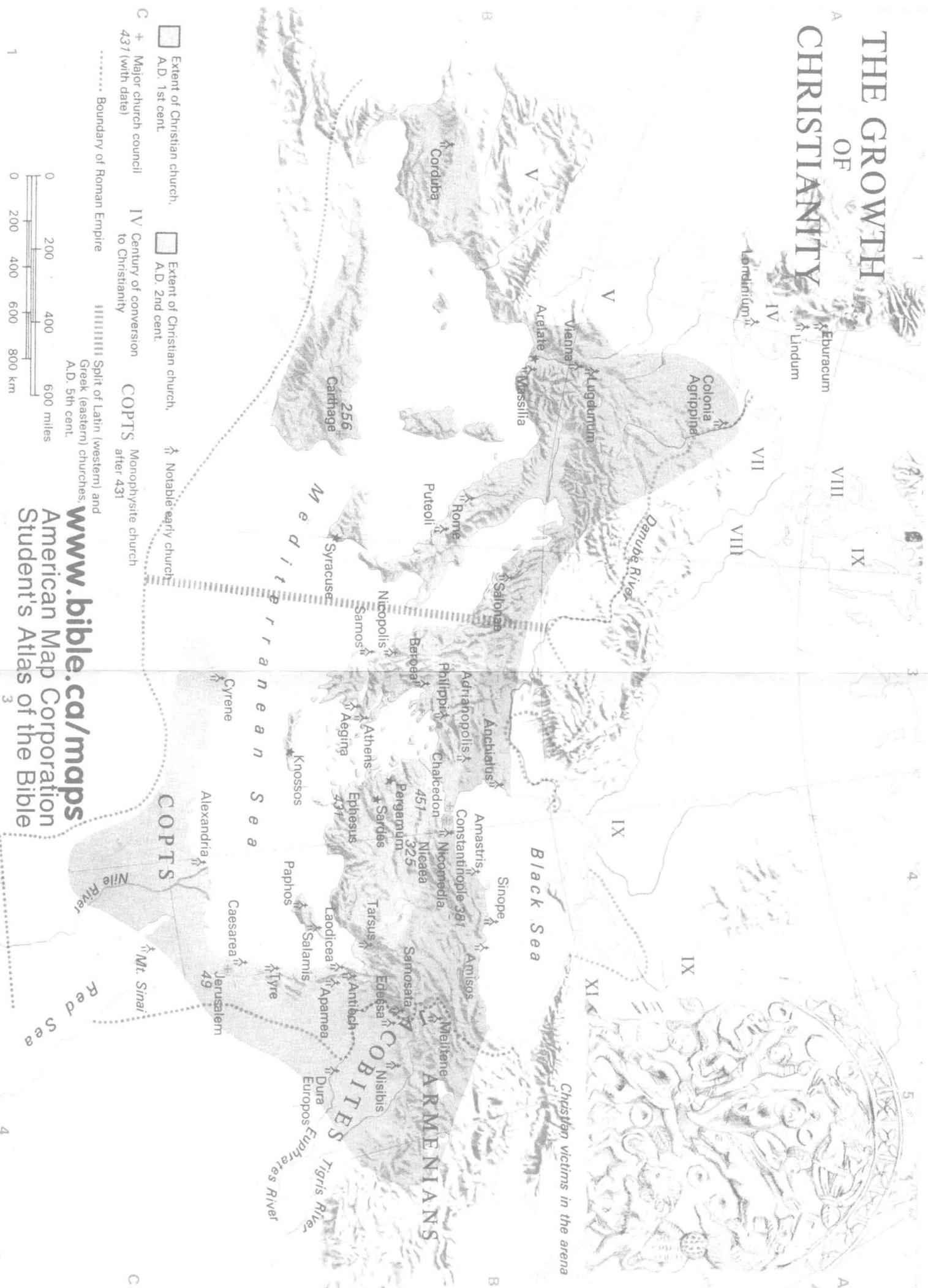
