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前 言

SHARPEN YOUR EARS 为清华大学外语系编写的《新英语教程》系列教科书的听力练习册。全书共分三册,第一册计有十六个单元,每个单元包括三部分,其中。

Part One, 含十个单句或五至十个短对话, 主要是进行一些微技能训练。有易混词辨别, 缩略语和疑问词填写, 数字听力等, 旨在训练学生听辨单词的能力。

Part Two, 含五个小对话,第三者就对话内容提问,学生从四个答案中进行选择练习。

Part Three, 含两篇趣味小故事, 每篇后录 有 五 个 问题, 学生做多项性选择练习。

第一部分中多数句子和对话是从英、美等国录制的原声带中摘录的,每句录两遍。第二、三部分由美籍教师录音,语迹为每分钟100—120词左右。为了增加磁带的容量,后两部分的内容只录了一遍,如果学生感到困难,可以播放两次。十六个单元平均分布在四盒磁带上,每个单元的录音时间为13—15分钟。

本册可用作大学英语一、二级听力课上的补充练习,亦可以留作家庭作业,不学《新英语教程》的学生和英语自学者均可用它来提高自己的听音理解能力。使用时先听磁带,做练习,再对照答案,记下自己的成绩。如有不明白的地方可看所附的文字材料。

本册已在清华大学试用过两次,深受同学们欢迎。全书

由李相崇教授审阅,陈圣信副教授以及本校外语系的一些教师提出过许多宝贵意见,我们在此表示衷心的感谢。

本材料和录音磁带虽经两次试用和修改,但由于编者水平有限,一定还有不少缺点和错误,热忱希望老师和同学们批评指正。
