前 言

为了适应我国课程改革及中学英语教学的实际需要,我们以教育.部颁布的《英语课程标准》为依据,组织具有丰富教学经验和较高编.写水平的重点中学一线教师及教研人员,遵循初中三年级学生的身心发展规律和素质教育的理念,编写了这本《新标准英语听说练(初中三年级上册)》,供初中三年级学生使用。

本书依照"题材—功能—结构—任务"的总体思路编写,着力于 开发学生学习潜能,启迪学生思维。在栏目设计及内容安排上既注意 基础知识的落实,又着重综合运用语言能力的培养;既充分反映教材 特色,又体现课程改革精神。

本书每个模块由 MODULE GOALS, LISTENING, SPEAKING, GRAMMAR AND VOCABULARY, READING, WRITING 等板块组成。

MODULE GOALS 概括提出本模块中听、说、读、写的总体要求,引领学生明确学习"任务"。LISTENING 考虑初中三年级学生的年龄特点,紧扣教材内容,图文并茂,配有录音材料和录音磁带,旨在培养学生通过听来获取英语语言信息的能力。SPEAKING 围绕教材规定的任务,根据学生知识结构及认知规律,设计了便于学生上口的对话材料,以培养学生"动口"的能力。GRAMMAR AND VOCAB-ULARY 设计灵活多样的语法、词汇、词组、句型等操练材料,旨在培养学生语言的基础和技能。READING 提供题材丰富、内容新颖、语言地道的阅读文段,旨在培养学生的阅读理解能力。WRITING 结合学生所学语言知识,给出提示语,让学生按要求写短文;或只给出题目,给学生留出充分的想象空间,使其有感而发、有话可写,以尽快提高英语写作水平。


