《牛津小学生英汉双解词典》的原版为牛津大学出版社出版的 Oxford Junior Illustrated Dictionary; 商务印书馆引进并出版发行其英汉双解简体字本; 本词典是牛津英语学习词典系列中的一个新成员,也是第一部牛津小学生英汉双解词典。

本词典是由英国著名儿童词汇专家专为小学生设计的一部学习型词典。商务印书馆根据中国小学生英语学习现状,充分考虑其兴趣爱好、知识结构、学习需求等诸方面因素,并参考《义务教育英语课程标准》,对收词、附录等做了必要的补充,以期更有效地帮助中国小学生学习英语词汇、掌握英语知识。

全书收词 4400 余条,均为基础英语词汇,每条均配有国际音标;释义尽量避免使用生僻难懂的词语,释义程度和例证选配均充分考虑小学生读者的接受能力;所选的 400 余幅插图活泼亮丽,有助于加深理解和形象记忆。

我们还特别制作了配套多媒体光盘。词典中所有的词目、词目的变体形式、汉语释义及例证均由发音标准的专业配音人员录制,可更好地帮助小学生读者学习标准的英语发音。除具备普通的查询功能外,光盘还提供了多种辅助学习功能,帮助小读者们有效地记忆英语单词。

在版式及装帧设计方面,充分考虑小学生的阅读习惯,全书彩色印刷,双语文字均使 用大字体,版面宽松适度,多方面提高小学生的学习兴趣,关注小学生的视力健康。


