前言

教育部高等教育司 2007 年颁布的《大学英语课程教学要求》指出:"大学英语的教学目标是培养学生英语综合应用能力,特别是听说能力,使他们在今后工作和社会交往中能用英语有效地进行口头和书面的信息交流,同时增强其自主学习能力、提高综合文化素养,以适应我国经济发展和国际交流的需要。"《大学英语口语教程》正是为训练和提高"学生英语综合应用能力,特别是听说能力"这一目标而编写的。

全国有民办院校 300 多所,但由于各种原因,能满足这些院校学生实际需求的英语教材相对较少,口语方面的教材就更是寥寥无几。《大学英语口语教程》面向民办院校及同等水平院校的非英语专业本科生,可作为大学英语听说课堂教学,也可以作为第二课堂自主学习教材,帮助学生提高英语会话和表达能力。

本书遵循"输入输出相结合,先输入后输出"的教学理念,贯彻"听读先行,说背跟上,以听促说"的原则,以话题为导向,循序渐进地培养和训练学生基本的日常会话能力,为英语综合应用能力的培养奠定基础。

本书每个单元由5个部分组成:

- I. Listen and Repeat
- II. Listening Dictation
- III. Recitation
- IV. Role Play
- V. Further Learning

本书每个单元给出相关话题的英语日常口语句子 15 个,通过听读、听写、背诵句子,以及情景对话练习等形式巩固记忆句子,训练有关该话题的日常会话交流。扩展训练(Further Learning)由成语、习语等内容组成,以加强学生语言知识和英语文化的拓展和积累。

本书的编者均为多年从事大学英语教学的一线教师,他们教学经验丰富,了解学生的语言程度和需求,衷心希望这本凝结了他们心血的《大学英语口语教程》能够满足民办院校学生迫切希望提高英语口语水平的需求,为探索民办院校英语听说教学尽一份微薄之力。


