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Foreword 前言

The government of the Republic of China has established the Taiwan Academy overseas in order to promote worldwide interest in Taiwan's Chinese culture. Showcasing the essence of Taiwanese culture and its "soft power", the Taiwan Academy activates as an important medium through which Taiwan can increase its presence on the international stage and serve as a platform to facilitate a better understanding of Taiwan through her culture among the international community.

In order to help promote Taiwan's academic research, the Center for Chinese Studies (CCS) and National Central Library (NCL) have published this booklet introducing the "Taiwan Academy", the "Taiwan Resource Center for Chinese Studies (TRCCS)" and the Academia Sinica Digital Center's "Digital Taiwan: Culture & Nature project" (originally the Taiwan e-Learning and Digital Archives Program run by the National Science Council, the Ministry of Science and Technology's predecessor). This booklet also lists 88 of Taiwan's most significant Taiwan studies and Sinological research websites and databases, each of which has been carefully chosen, categorized, and briefly introduced in English.

To complete this rich and comprehensive guide for foreign scholars to Taiwan's research resources, at the back of the booklet there is a bilingual website index and information about the Taiwan Fellowship & Scholarships (TFAS).

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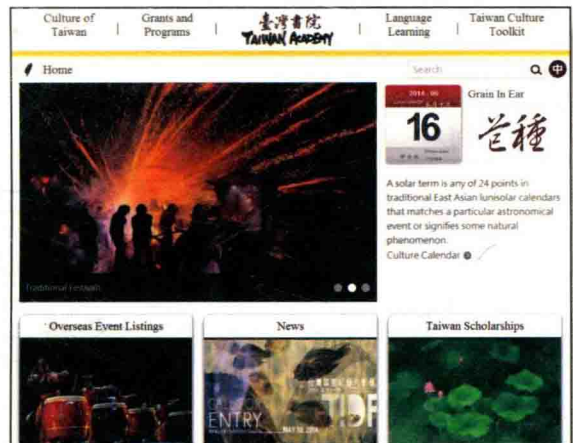

Taiwan is a major center of Chinese culture. To accompany the founding of the Taiwan Academy, the virtual Taiwan Academy, a platform highlighting the unique qualities of Chinese culture, has been established. Building on Taiwan's particular characteristics and strengths, and employing Taiwan's advanced information and digital technologies, the virtual Taiwan Academy is a platform which combines the aims of promoting Mandarin Chinese teaching and traditional Chinese characters, encouraging Taiwan studies and Sinological research, and showcasing Taiwan's many cultures. It serves as an important medium for cultural interaction between Taiwan and the international community, as well as a platform via which the international community can learn more about Taiwan's overall development.

The immediacy and worldwide accessibility of the virtual Taiwan Academy showcases Taiwan's achievements in advanced software development, expertise in digital information development, and deep inner strength of its Chinese culture. The main themes of the virtual Taiwan Academy are Culture of Taiwan, Grants and Programs, Language Learning, and Taiwan Culture Toolkit. It combines Taiwan's rich and specialized databases with a web portal, providing access to these resources free of charge for people around the world interested in Chinese language and culture, and demonstrating the Republic of China's prowess in both technological and business endeavors.

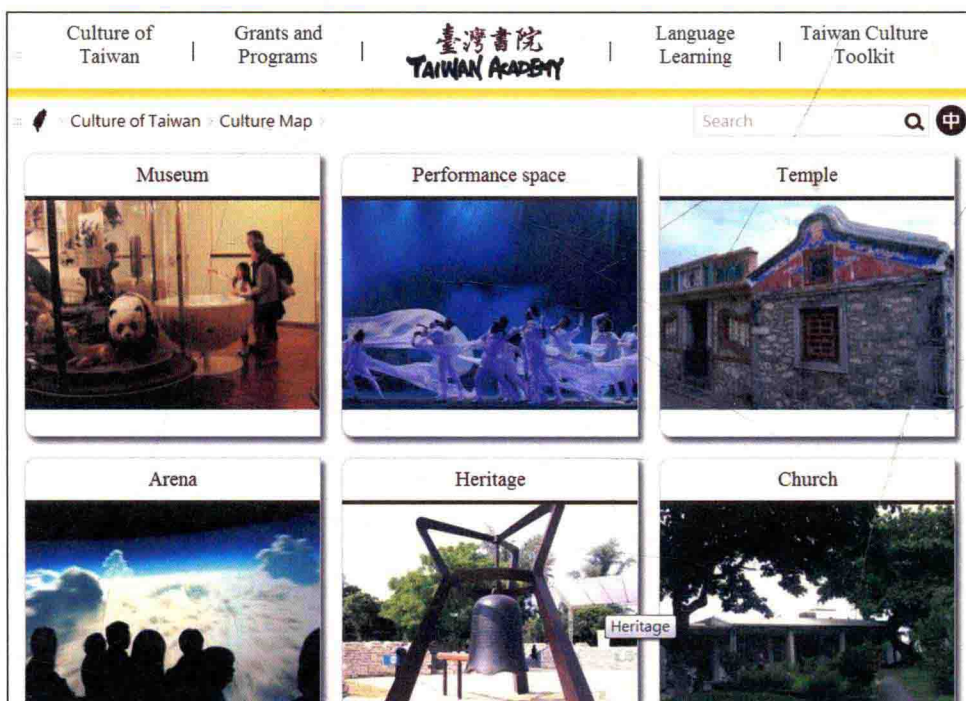


The Taiwan Academy aims to provide people around the world with access to


The government of the Republic of China has established the Taiwan Academy (<http://taiwanacademy.tw>) in order to promote worldwide interest in Taiwan's Chinese culture.

“Taiwan studies and Sinology research” has been regarded as one of the major collections by National Central Library (NCL). The Center for Chinese Studies (CCS) under the NCL was established in 1981. It offers diverse service, such as material collection, event reports, publication, research grant and academic activities. These services are highly appreciated by domestic and international Sinology experts. Its goal is right in harmony with which of Taiwan Academy, therefore, the CCS and NCL was assigned by Ministry of Education to promote the program of Taiwan Academy.

To coordinate the government's policy, the National Central Library (NCL) started to devote to the establishment of Taiwan Academy since 2011. To showcase Taiwan's achievements in Taiwan Studies and Sinology research, the NCL had set up Resource Points in New York, Los Angeles and Houston that provide important access to Taiwan's academic research, and introduces top human society publications produced by Taiwan's governmental and nongovernmental institutions. Meanwhile, the NCL established “Taiwan Resource Center for Chinese Studies” abroad and held “Taiwan Lectures on Chinese Studies” and exhibitions to promote an interest in Chinese culture with Taiwanese characteristics around the world.

In line with the internationalization of Chinese studies and efforts by the Taiwanese government to promote "Chinese culture with Taiwanese characteristics," the National Central Library (NCL) began in 2012 to establish overseas Taiwan Resource Center for Chinese Studies (TRCCS) based on the library's publication exchange ties and three decades of academic interactions in the field of Chinese studies. Located at major universities and research institutes abroad, the center aims to promote international exchanges in Chinese studies, promote Taiwan's achievements in Sinology, collaboratively build a global Sinological resource and information platform and broaden and deepen cultural exchanges between the Chinese and Western worlds.

The TRCCS serves following specific functions:

1. Presenting Taiwan's achievements and academic resources in the field of Chinese studies

TRCCS partner organizations annually receive books, audio-visual materials and e-resources published in Taiwan. The NCL has also established an IP channel for partner organizations to search the digital resources of the library, the CCS and major institutes in Taiwan within copyright limits. In addition, the library provides a collection of links to other Sinological resources in Taiwan to further serve scholars and experts and expand research ability with win-win results.

2. Promoting international exchanges in Chinese studies

The TRCCS is established at prominent centers for Chinese studies and key universities with development potential. These partners are chosen to facilitate joint promotion of academic and professional exchanges supported by the research resources and influence of the collaborating organization. In addition, the NCL plans to jointly organize academic or cultural activities related to Chinese studies with partner organizations. The NCL will also add links on its website to overseas TRCCS branches and report related activities to further develop the role of the

centers as an interactive platform in the Chinese studies community.

3. Enhancing global cultural substance and inclusiveness

By the end of 2014, the NCL will have established 12 centers in the United States, Russia, the United Kingdom, Germany, Latvia, Malaysia, Vietnam, the Netherlands, Czech Republic, and Japan. In building up the Taiwan and Chinese studies resources at these centers, the NCL aims to jointly enrich local cultural substance with partner organizations. This collaborative process has also highlighted a strong interest in Chinese studies among non-Chinese communities. Even more encouraging has been the mutual appreciation and learning witnessed between different cultures and the significant progress it enables in replacing cultural conflict and opposition with reconciliation and peace.

配合漢學研究國際化以及政府向世界推廣「具有臺灣特色的中華文化」之施政方向，國家圖書館（以下簡稱國圖）在既有之出版品交換及 30 年的漢學研究學術交流基礎上，自民國 101 年起於海外設立「臺灣漢學資源中心」（Taiwan Resource Center for Chinese Studies，簡稱 TRCCS），選擇國外重點大學或研究機構設置，加強與各國漢學研究單位合作，推動海內外漢學學術交流，傳布臺灣漢學學術成果，共同建置全球漢學研究資源與訊息平臺，促進中西文化交流的廣度與深度。

「臺灣漢學資源中心」的設置將發揮以下幾項具體的功能：

1. 提供臺灣漢學研究成果及學術資源利用平臺

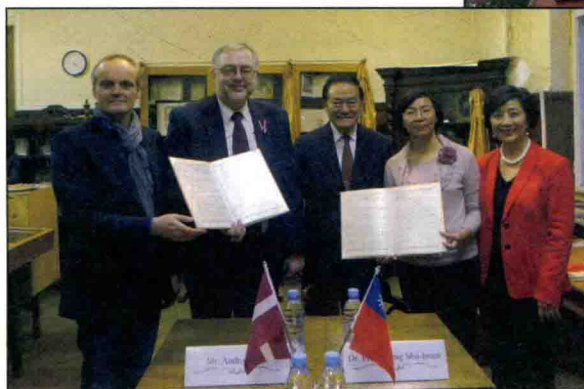
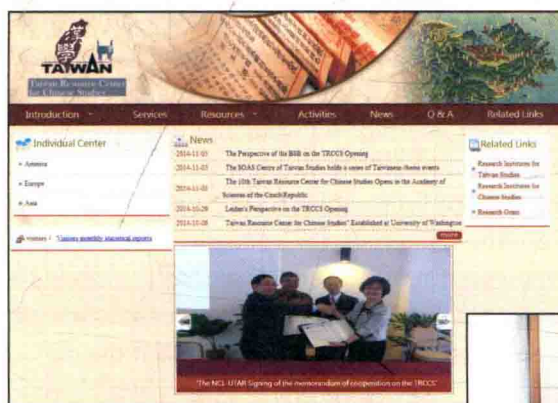
「臺灣漢學資源中心」的合作單位將可每年獲得臺灣出版的書刊，視聽資料及電子資源；在無著作權之疑慮下，國圖將以設定 IP 的方式提供合作單位查詢使用國圖及漢學研究中心建置的數位資源。國圖並將整理國內其他單位建置的漢學研究資源，供合作單位放置網站進行連結，服務學者專家，達到擴充學者研究能量，彼此互惠雙贏的目的。

2. 促進國內外漢學研究學術交流

設置 TRCCS 的合作單位皆是各國知名的漢學研究重鎮或深具發展潛力的重點大學，藉其學術研究資源及其影響力，共同推展學術及專業交流。國圖將與合作單位共同辦理有關漢學研究之學術或文化活動。並將於網站建立海外「臺灣漢學資源中心」之連結並報導相關活動。讓此中心扮演漢學界另一互動平臺。

3. 豐富世界文明內涵並提升文明之間的包容性

截至民國 103 年底，「臺灣漢學資源中心」已陸續設立於美國、俄羅斯、英國、德國、拉脫維亞、馬來西亞、越南、荷蘭、捷克、日本等國，共計 12 處。藉由充實 TRCCS 的臺灣與漢學研究資源，國圖與這些合作單位共同豐富當地的文明內涵。合作過程我們也看到這些非華人學術社群對於漢學研究展現極高的興趣，更令人感到鼓舞的是，似乎看到文明之間彼此的欣賞與學習，逐漸突破傳統的文明衝突、對立，朝向文明之間的調和與和平大步邁進。

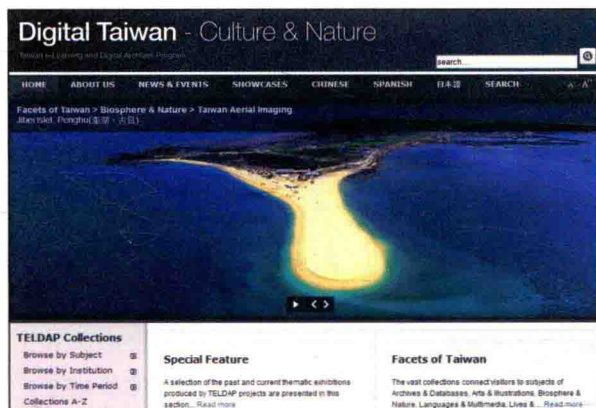

DigitalArchives.tw is a platform created to showcase the work of the Academia Sinica Digital Center. It gathers together over 100 websites and applications containing one million items created by the National Science Council's National Digital Archives Program (2002-2007) and Taiwan E-learning and Digital Archives Program (2008-2012), and aims to provide an interface for searching the contents of the nation's digital archives. The content of almost 100 of the nation's digital archives spanning more than ten academic fields can be accessed in a single window on the webpage and used not only to find resource materials for education and research and as a value-added catalogue for industrial applications, but also to provide a superb platform for browsing Taiwan's digital archives useful for academic research, educational development and business applications. Readers can approach the digital

archives in four ways: Special Collections—explore selected archives; Guided Tour—browse the myriad items in the national archives; Experience—be the first to experience the latest archive technology; and Research Website Resources.



The owners and providers of the national program's digital content are research institutions.

The archives of these participating institutions each contain all kinds of culturally and historically important artifacts and files, and each has its own special characteristics. The digital archives not only allow these relics to be preserved, but by widening access, can also popularize refined culture and enable it to be used in all kinds of products. Some important participating institutions are briefly introduced below:

典藏臺灣 (DigitalArchives.tw) 是由中央研究院數位文化中心所建立的成果展示平台，結合行政院國家科學委員會（現為科技部）「數位典藏國家型科技計畫」（2002~2007 年）以及「數位典藏與數位學習國家型科技計畫」（2008~2012 年）時期建置的百萬筆典藏素材、上百件網站資源與應用案例，旨在提供全國性數位典藏藏品的檢索與搜尋。透過單一網站窗口，即可檢索全國近百組跨十餘個學術領域之數位典藏內容，不僅可作為教育研究素材與產業應用加值目錄，同時也是提供學術研究、教育發展與企業應用之最佳瀏覽平臺。讀者亦可以經由「珍藏——探索精選典藏」、「導覽——隨時瀏覽百萬國家典藏」、「體驗——搶先體驗典藏新科技」、「成果網站資源」四個主題了解數位典藏。

研究機構是國家型計畫數位內容的擁有者與提供者，這些參與機構典藏有國家各類重要文物及檔案，且各有特色。透過數位典藏，不僅讓文物得以保存，更能應用推廣使精緻文化普及化並加值應用於各項產業上。以下列舉重要參與單位：

There are approximately 4800 kinds of journals and more than 2.22 million articles have been collected. Academic journals published before 1970 are also available.

The Citation analysis and reports in TCI-HSS is based on the contents of Taiwan Social Sciences Citation Index (TSSCI) and Taiwan Humanities Citation Index (THCI). With the data merging by Science & Technology Policy Research and Information Center, TCI-HSS is able to provide the citation analysis among academic references and scholarly papers, which can provide indicators as the quality of national academic and research performances. TCI-HSS currently includes humanities and social sciences journals, National Digital Library of Theses and Dissertation in Taiwan, monographs with specialized citations contributed by domestic and overseas professionals. To help users understand and learn comprehensive referencing network, building up academic and primary references with diversified search criteria is the prioritized purpose of TCI-HSS. Other functionalities provided by TCI-HSS are listed as follows: (1) Crossing-disciplines-index service platform.(2) The analysis of bibliographic indexes refers to cited and citing references.(3) A major database and citation index in humanities and social sciences field.(4) The main reference for academic organizations and research institutes.
