削 Preface

为将来的涉外学习、工作和生活扫除语言障碍,如何选择适合自己的英语口语教材?生活在信息爆炸的今天,你一定为形形色色的选择所困惑。目前市场上流通的很多口语教材在难易度把握、内容的实用性以及表达的准确性和地道等方面都不能真正满足英语口语学习者的需求。《全彩图解版——外教英语听说》系列教材在创新体例和框架下,因循语言输入和输出的科学规律,借鉴和整合目前的口语教材的通用话题,汲取现行口语教材的优点,为读者提供了了从易而难,从直观到思辨的渐进语料。

该系列教材由"初级入门"、"初级基础"和"初级飞跃"3本有机结合而成,每本教材均包含12个独立的话题。编者按照话题的难易程度科学地对话题进行了梯度遴选和组材,为读者的口语学习提供了丰富的的素材,以期达到循序渐进、细雨润物的效果。其内容涵盖周围人物、学校生活、体育爱好、外出就餐、动物世界、志愿工作、娱乐时尚、职业规划、现代科技、身心健康、金融领域以及成功理念等与读者生活息息相关的话题。话题涉及面广、时效性强,能极大地激发学生的兴趣和参与热情,通过模仿提升其再造能力。

每个单元的形式设计也体现了编者的独具匠心,每个单元包括 4 个口语学习模块:话题导入(Topic Preview)、听力操练(Time to Listen)、会话操练(Time to Talk)、阅读操练(Time to Read)。这 4 个模块的设计与安排可以使读者对该话题进行深度思考和挖掘:一方面通过地道有趣的模拟对话和原汁原味的阅读材料使读者完成相关话题的语料输入,另一方面通过精心设计的图片、问题、辩论等引领读者进行语言的模仿和输出。

同时,本书体现了英语口语学习螺旋上升的规律: 语料输入——思维形成——不断反复——质的飞越,旨在使读者的口语学习在每一个阶段都能真实有效。在会话操练(Time to Talk)这一模块中,本书提供了和话题相呼应的精美插图,不仅为读者提供了文字的思考,更进一步通过图画的视觉冲击,帮助读者树立英语思维的习惯; 同时,本书由外籍专家参与撰写和审定,更进一步确保了语料输入过程中语言的真实有效性。


