#### 1.2. Information Desk

Two Athletics Information Desks for the athletic competition of 1st East Asian Games will be established. One is in the hotel where all teams stay, the other is by the Call Room of Hong kou Stadium. It opens 08:00-18:00 daily from May 2 to May 16, 1993.

Programmes, results, final confirmation forms, shuttle bus schedule and other information are available at these two Athletics Information Desks. The duly filled final confirmation forms should be submitted to the Information Desk in the hotel before 12:00 two days prior to the start of the given event.

Any protest or appeal should be made in time according to IAAF Rule Article 147 to the Information Desk at the Stadium. Late protests will not be accepted. English and Chinese languages are spoken at the Desk.

#### 2. Technical Information

#### 2.1. Competition Sites

2.1.1 Technical Data of Hong Kou Stadium

9-lane 400m synthetic track with 36mm curve radius, its axis is in the north-south direction;

- 3 triple jump runways;
- 2 long jump runways;
- 2 high jump areas;
- 2 pole vault runways;
- 1 discus and hammer circle

2 javelin runways

#### 2.1.2 Timing and Measuring System

In track events, photo finish timing system will be provided by the Technical Department of the Organizing Committee. In jumping and throwing events, measuring will be done with equipment provided by the Technical Department of the Organizing Committee.

#### 2.1.3 Video Recording System for Jury

All competitions will be filmed by video cameras. In case protests are lodged, these video tapes will be available upon the request of the chief referee and Jury.

#### 2.1.4 Starting list and Results

Starting List and results could be obtained from the Information Desk. At the end of each competition day, team managers may collect a copy of complete daily results from the Information Desk.

During competitions, the starting list for finals of the track events will be posted in the athletes' residence.

#### 2.1.5 Medical services

A clinic will be set up in the hotel where athletes stay with 24 hours first—aid service. Clinics at the competition and training venues will provide first-aid service to all participants.

#### 2.2. Training Sites

Hongkou Stadium and the Shanghai Sports School will provide training facilities.
