前 言

《大学英语四级考试词汇教程》是根据国家教委 1999 年最新颁发的《大学英语教学大纲通用词汇表 (1—4 级)》编写而成。本书旨在帮助考生在短期内,通过强化训练,全面有效地提高词汇的综合运用能力,从而顺利通过大学英语四级考试。

众所周知,词汇是英语学习的基础,庞大的词汇量和熟练的词汇掌握在很大程度上是学生能否通过大学英语四级考试的关键。本书的参编者长期主持大学英语四级教学和研究工作,有着丰富的四级考试教学和辅导经验,我们根据教学中学生的主要难点和需求,编写了这本手册。全书由二十五套测试题组成,每套题共有 100小题,分为四个部分,第一部分是选词填空,第二部分是按提示填空,第三部分是同义词替换,第四部分是综合选择填空。书中所选词汇基本覆盖了大学四级词汇中的中心词汇,通过各种题型的练习,以达到让学生灵活、牢固掌握词汇的目的。

在编写过程中,我们参阅了国内外大量的有关材料和著作,恕不一一注明出处,再此一并致谢。

由于时间仓促,编者水平和经验有限,难免出现疏漏之处,恳请广大同行及读者批评指正。
