

# What Is Logistics?

The term logistics can be traced back to ancient Greece where the original term logos meant ratio, calculation and reason. At that time, the person engaged in logistics was responsible for ensuring supplies to be distributed correctly. Even then, military commanders were aware of the importance of good logistics for their victory in the war. In history, many military operations owed their failure to lacking an efficient logistic line.

Then what is modern logistics? A widespread concept is that logistics is "the movement of goods". But in fact, that is a narrow concept. Logistics is much more and much wider than mere physical handling of goods. It is the management of the flow of goods, information and other resources, including energy and people, between the point of origin and the point of consumption in order to meet the requirements of consumers or corporations. Logistics involves the integration of information, transportation, inventory, warehousing, material handling, packaging and often security.

Simply, logistics can be described as the art of achieving the "six rights", which include:

- > getting the right things (or people);
- > in the right quantity;
- > to the right place;
- > at the right time;



By the scope of geography that logistics spans, we can divide it into regional logistics, national logistics as well as international logistics. According to the subject of logistics activities, it falls into the first-party logistics, the second-party logistics, the third-party logistics as well
