“How are you?” It's a question that seems simple, but it can actually make people feel very strange.

Last month, Alina Simone wrote to *New York Times* about the difficulty that Russians have with this question. The same question, in Russian language and culture is always answered in a negative (负面的) manner. In Russian, when people are asked “How are you?”, they usually complain about health, weather or things that have happened recently. So when they're asked “How are you?” in English, they don't know what to do.

In English-speaking countries, “How are you?” has one standard answer “Fine, and you?” That's because “How are you?” is not actually about getting information—it's a greeting. If a native English-speaking friend really wants to know what's going on in your life, he or she is more likely to ask: “What have you been up to?” or “What's new?”

Today, instead of “How are you”, young American often use the simple greeting “What's up” or “Sup”. The standard response is “Not much, you?”, or even “Yo”.
