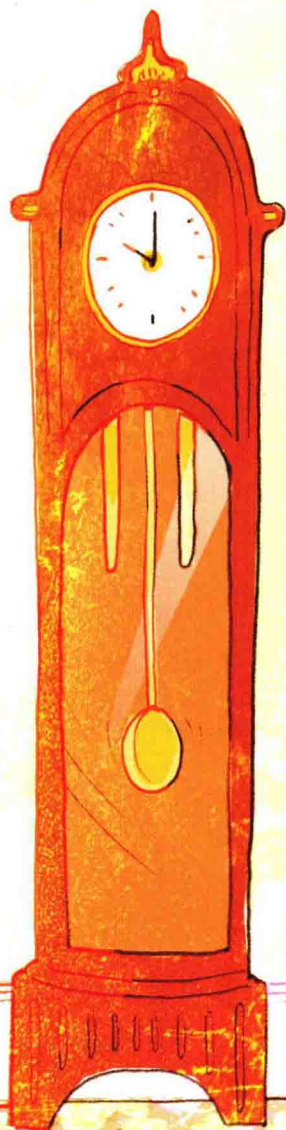
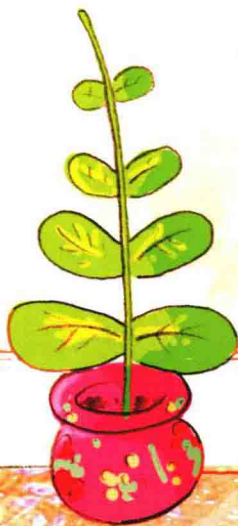

Miss Petal was a sweet, sweet old lady. Everybody said that Growly was lucky to live with her.



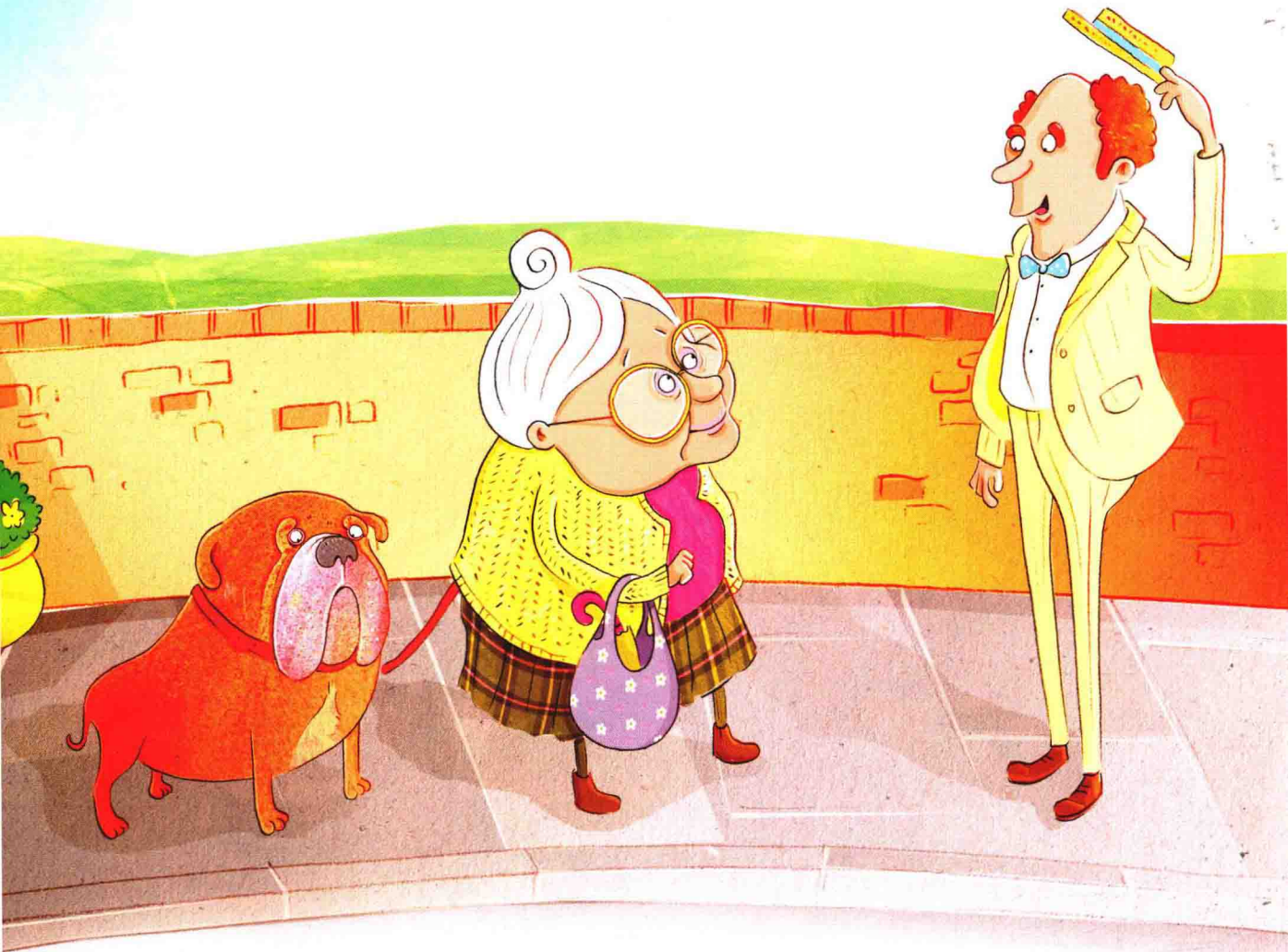
One day, Miss Petal said, "We're going to the shops for some apples."

And they went off down the road.

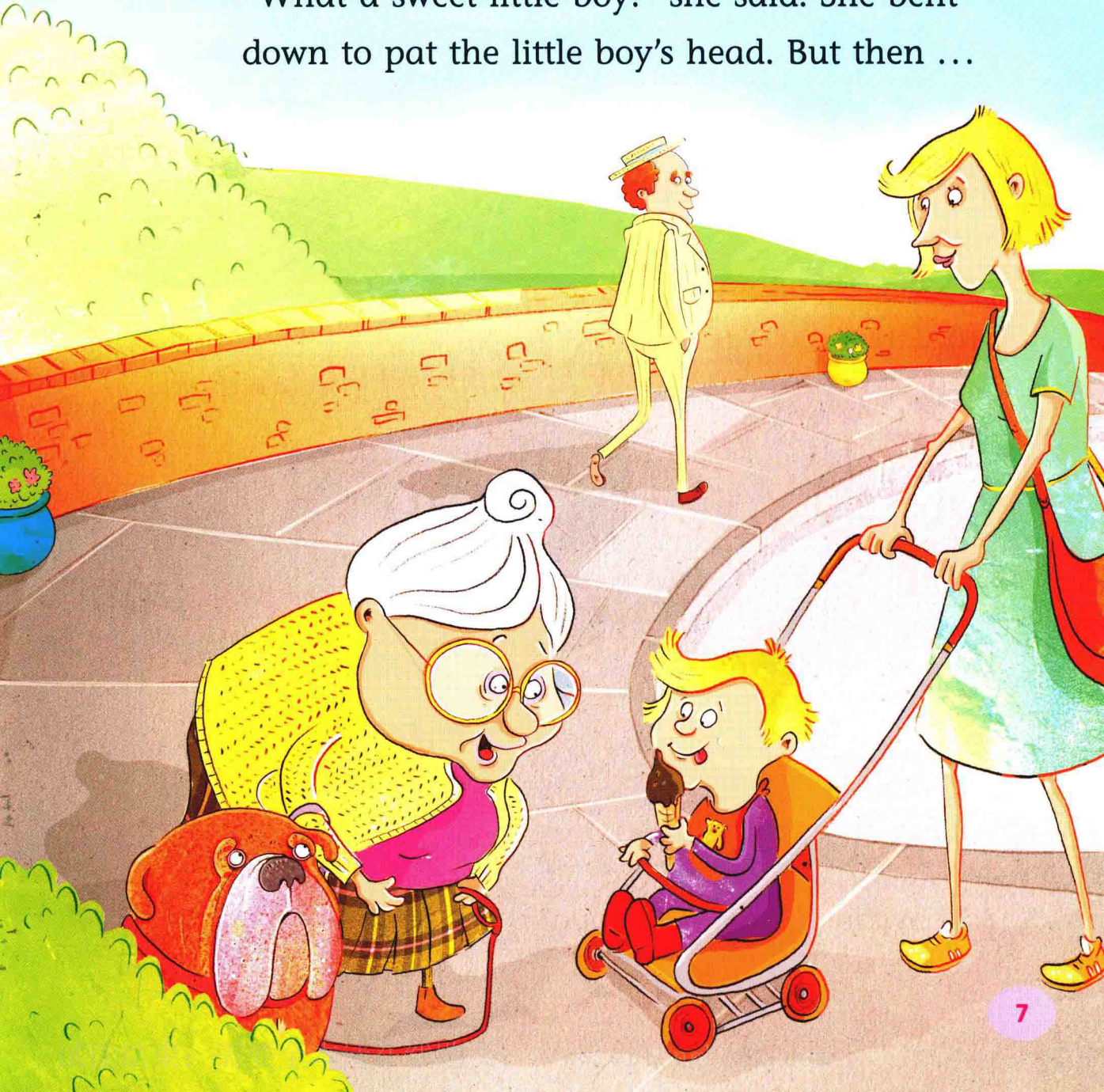
“Good morning, Miss Petal,” said a man in a hat.



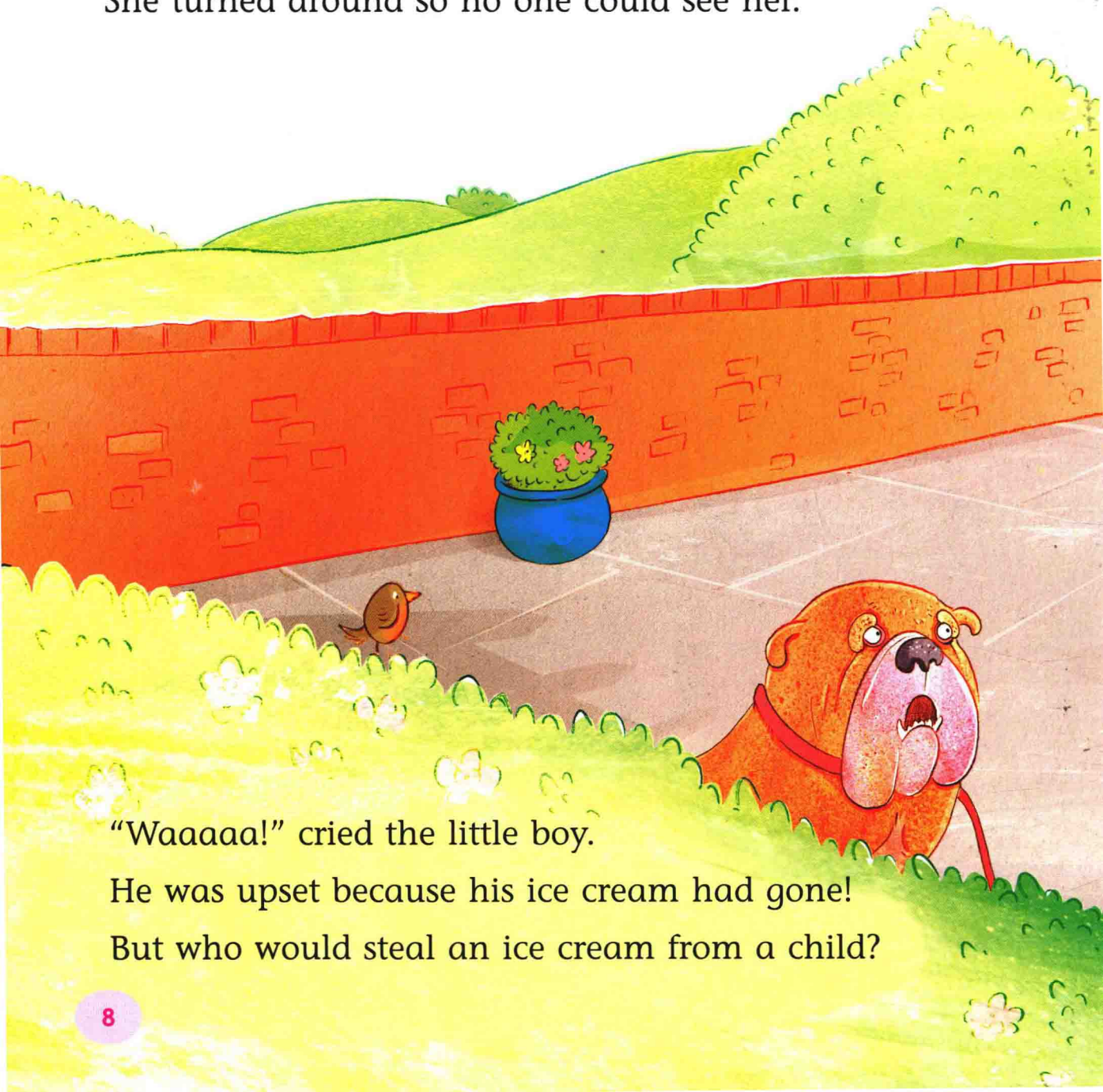
“Good morning,” said Miss Petal sweetly. “I am going to get some apples to make an apple pie.”

“That’s nice,” said the man in the hat.


Miss Petal saw a mum with a pushchair.

They came to a lady in a pink coat.

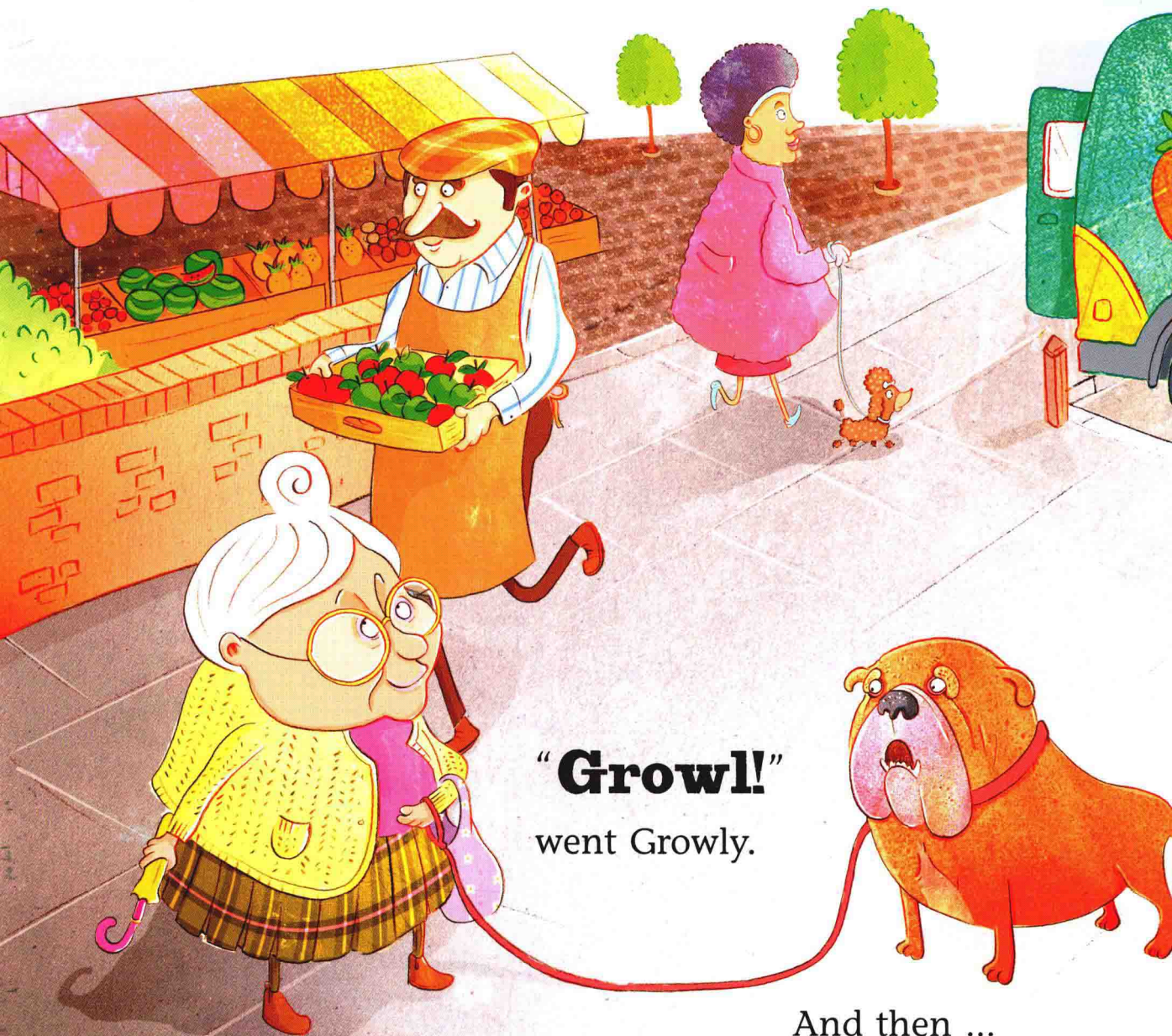


“What a lovely dog you have,” said Miss Petal sweetly.
