为了到达山顶，诺
克在钢丝上攀登了
348米的高度。

在行走过程中，诺克

还抬起了一只脚。

为了保持平衡，在
大多数情况下，诺克
都是靠脚尖在行走。

向着德国**最高峰**的山顶进发，
脚下是只有**5厘米**宽的**钢丝**，
而且**没有**依靠平衡杆以及**安全网**！

特殊技能：这只来自美国加利福尼亚的小羊正在和它的人类朋友一起**乘风破浪**。

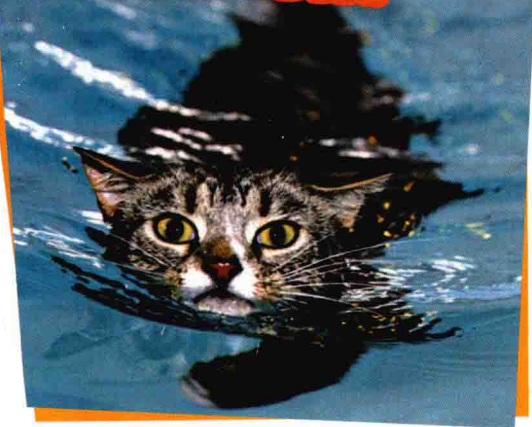
有趣的事：匹斯莫和它的母亲——哥提甚至还创建了它们自己的**博客主页**。

有趣的事：拿宁来自泰国的**一家动物救助中心**，这个中心的大象们还会为游客表演舞蹈。

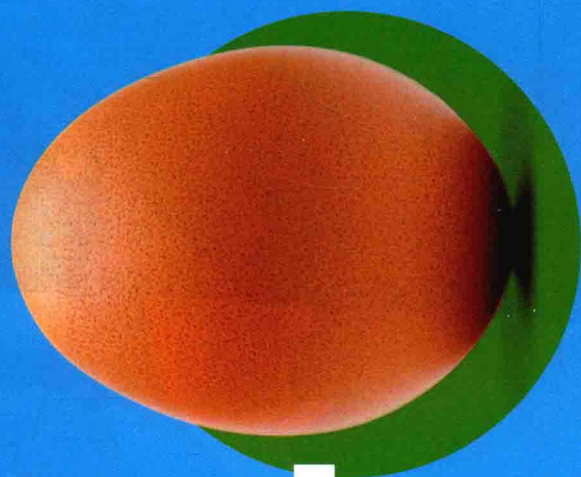
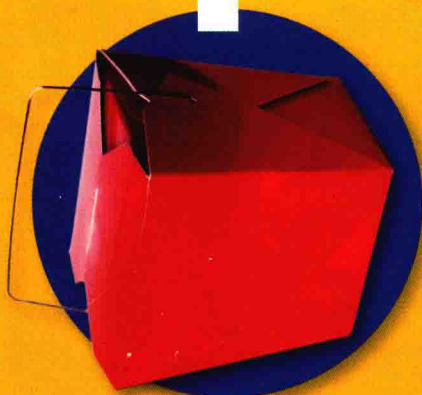

重量：约5080千克。

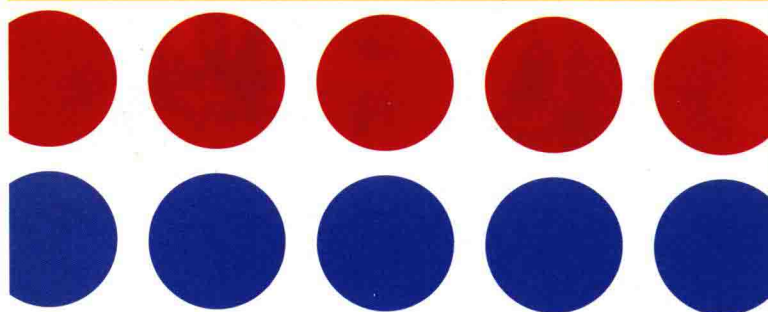

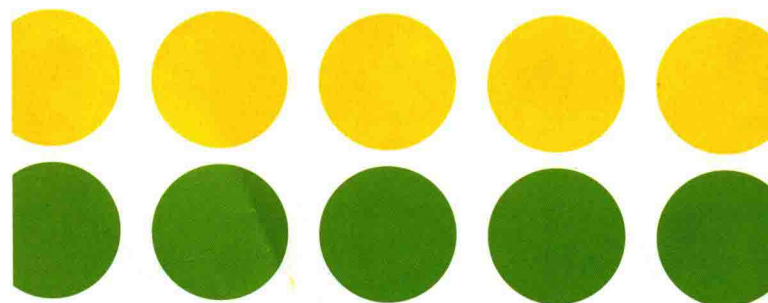

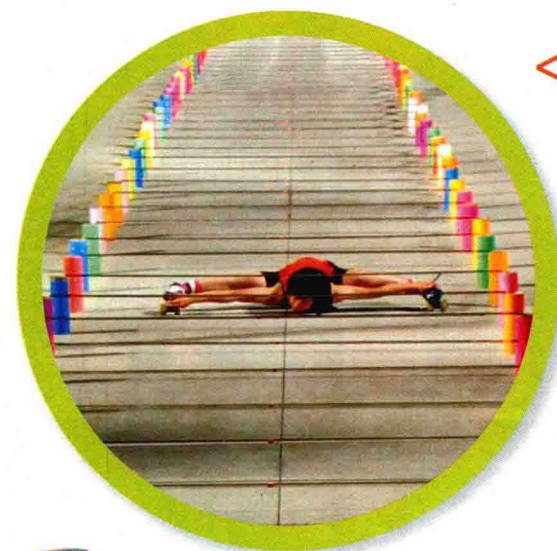
