内容提要

一、编写说明

为适应我国高等职业教育的发展,推动教学改革的不断深入,我们在认真调研、广泛征求意见的基础上,根据教育部《高职高专教育英语课程基本要求》,编写了《大学实用英语教程》系列教材供全国高职高专院校使用。本套教材贯彻实用为本的设计理念,体现新时期高职英语的特点,符合高职英语的教学需求,涵盖学生需要掌握的实用英语语言知识和交际技能。本套教材旨在把听说读写译有机地结合起来,注重培养学生的职场通识英语语言的实际应用能力、沟通能力和创新能力,引导学生在实践中正确地运用英语进行交际。

二、编写框架

本套教材充分吸收和借鉴了国内外优秀英语教材的优点,根据我国当前的英语教学要求和条件,我们进行了认真自主的规划、选材和编写。本套教材内容的选取紧密结合高职高专学生的学习和生活,注重学生的职业发展,激发学生的学习兴趣,奠定学生坚实的专业基础,同时也兼顾学生今后的求职需要,为就业做好铺垫。本套教材致力于全面提高学生实际应用英语的能力,促进学生自我发展能力的培养。

本套教材包括《大学实用英语教程》《大学实用英语教程同步拓展训练》(每一种均为 1~2 册)及配套的录音光盘等,其中教程的练习答案和参考译文都编入拓展训练中。

《大学实用英语教程》每册 10 个单元,每单元包括听、说、读、写、语法和名言警句6 个部分。全书语言知识与语言技能并举,各个部分环环相扣,使整个单元形成一个有机的整体,并以重点突出培养学生的应用能力为中心,循序渐进地引导学生达到既定的学习目标。

《大学实用英语教程同步拓展训练》是《大学实用英语教程》的配套拓展练习,10个单元与《大学实用英语教程》各单元主题呼应,提供形式多样的语言综合实训。其内容既是主教材的拓展和深入又与高等学校英语应用能力考试的A、B级密切相关。我们希望此书能为学生参加考试做好准备。

三、教材特色

本套教材具有以下特点:

1. 本教材体现了实用为主、够用为度的编写原则

本套教材全部由一线教师进行编写,难易程度把握适度,梯度明显,针对性强。我们依据学生的接受能力和实际需求选取学习内容,层次分明,结构紧凑,能够满足不同基础 学生的学习需要。
