

In the past twenty years or so, communication between our human species and other <u>56</u> has moved from the storybook to the scientific laboratory. Several experts have <u>57</u> to teach human language to apes and monkeys. One American psychologist trained his ape Sarah to make <u>58</u> on a computer.
