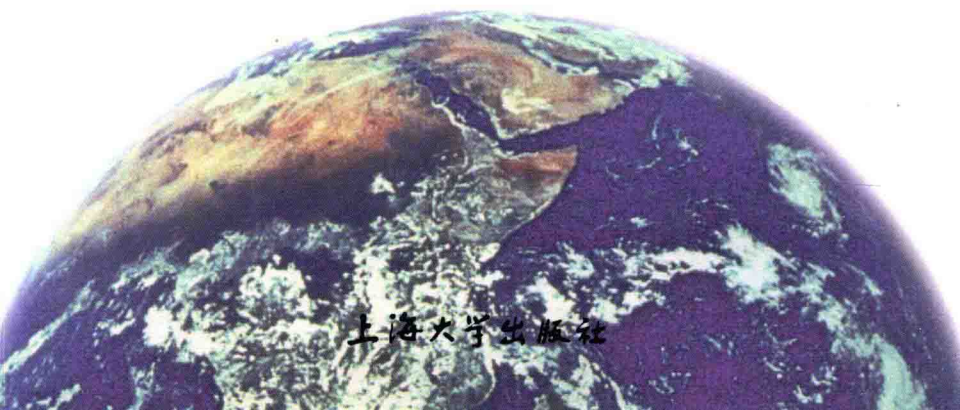

In the past twenty years or so, communication between our human species and other 56 has moved from the storybook to the scientific laboratory. Several experts have 57 to teach human language to apes and monkeys. One American psychologist trained his ape Sarah to make 58 on a computer. Another scientist trained an ape named Wash to make signs 59 words. A group of scientists in Africa 60 that monkeys use a series of cries, barks, and other sounds that we

61 call language. Is this evidence that in the future human beings and some of the 62 mammals will be able to communicate with each other through language?
