编者说明

本套书以国家教育部颁布的《普通高中英语课程标准》及最新《普通高等学校 招生全国统一考试北京卷考试说明》(以下简称为《考试说明》)为编写依据,从我 国中学生的英语学习实际出发,结合编者在几十年教学工作中的体会精心编写而成。

套书分为《高中英语词汇看这本就够了》和《高中英语词汇练这本就够了》两本。书中收录了最新《考试说明》中规定考生需要掌握的全部词汇,并结合在美国学习、生活中会遇到的常用词汇做了适度的扩展。

《高中英语词汇看这本就够了》分为释析、词义辨析和附录三部分。

"释析"部分中各词条除提供每个词的注音、词性及变化、汉语释义外,还有同义词、反义词提示及对重点词的用法、固定词语搭配、习惯用法、中心词构成的词组、基本句型等进行简明总结和举例说明,包括110多组近义词辨义。

"词义辨析"部分包括276组常用词词义辨析,较详细地说明了其中的区别, 并给出适量的例句进行整理、归纳。

"附录"分7部分,分别是常用不规则动词表;中学阶段词组;常用英语构词法;数字、月份、星期词汇表;常用缩略语表;主要国家名称及相关信息表及常见节日表等。

《高中英语词汇练这本就够了》中的练习题分三个层次:基础知识练习题;全国历届高考试题关于词汇的各种题型及真题集萃;强化练习题(基本上也是高考试题)。

本套书特别注重常用词一词多义的注释。常用词的词义多,用处往往也多,学生难以掌握。通过学习、使用本丛书,可以方便学生记忆词汇和扩大词汇量,帮助学生准确地掌握词汇的正确用法。

编写过程中,编者认真研究教学大纲、英语教材和近些年的高考英语试卷,结合多年教学和辅导高考的实践经验,以及学生在学习过程中的反馈,力争做到层次分明,简单扼要,重点突出,通俗易懂。编者对书中所有练习题都做了详细解析,主要目的是教给学生正确的解题思路和科学、简便的做题方法,从而提高学生的学习能力。

本套书密切结合中学教学的实际情况,便于学生自学、检测和提高。不仅可供 高中学生总复习用,对初、高中学生来说,也是很适用的工具书。希望本套书能成 为老师和学生的好帮手。

编写本套书的过程中得到许多老师、同仁、学生在收集资料、编写、整理材料等方面的帮助,编者对此表示衷心的感谢。

本次修订删除了较早几年的真题例解,新增了直至2015年的最新各国各地高考新试题,讲解了近年热考的新考点。由于水平和时间有限,书中不妥之处,敬请批评指正。
