Santa Claus Oh, hello, ladies and gentlemen. Remember Santa Claus. me? Here I am again. (takes off his red coat, hangs it up) I've just come back from my trip around the world. (sits down in his armchair) I'm so tired and my feet are aching<sup>①</sup>! (takes off his shoes and socks) In a few hours the children will be opening their presents and oh, how happy they will be! (lies back and smiles)

(Elves 1, 2 and 3 enter.)

Elf One Oh, hello, Santa! You're back at last! How was the trip this year?

Santa Claus Fine. Lots of snow, but my rein-

Elf Two (holding a tray with a cup of tea and a piece of cake) Great!

Here's a nice hot cup of tea for you and some cake, too (places the tray on the table in front of Santa Claus).

Santa Claus Wonderful! (begins to eat and drink) Mmmm! This is good. It was so cold, my feet are frozen<sup>2</sup>!

Elf Three (bringing over a hot foot bath<sup>®</sup>)
I've got a nice warm foot bath ready for you, Santa!

Santa Claus That's fantastic<sup>®</sup>! (puts his feet in the foot bath) Aaah! That feels good! Where's the newspaper?

(looks around, sees newspaper on the table and picks it up) Oh, here it is. Let's see what's new in the world.

(Elves 1, 2, and 3 exit<sup>5</sup>). Santa Claus opens the newspaper. He notices an article and begins to

"Santa Claus is old-fashioned<sup>③</sup>. He isn't up to date<sup>④</sup>. This fat, old man with a beard brings the children nothing but unhealthy sweets and unnecessary toys. His presents for adults<sup>⑤</sup> are not always very good either. Modern people need modern, useful, healthy presents. Sports clothes instead of chocolates! This old man needs

some modernizing<sup>®</sup>. Shave off<sup>®</sup> your beard, Mr Santa Claus!"

(While Santa Claus reads the article aloud, a Chinese translation is projected® on the wall for non-English-speaking guests in the audience.)

(Elves 1, 2, and 3 take the newspaper and read. Santa walks up and down. He is very annoyed<sup> $\mathbb{D}$ </sup>. The elves put down the newspaper.)

Elf Three Don't worry, Santa. We'll help you.

Elf Two Yes. We'll show those journalists what we can make of you.

Elf One Yes, a young, dynamic<sup>2</sup> Santa Claus!

Santa Claus Me?

Elf Two Of course!

Santa Claus You're all wonderful friends, but I'm too tired to think about this tonight. All I need now is my bed.
Me? Young? Dynamic? (shrugs

(Elves 4-8 enter.)

Elf Four Good morning, Santa. How are you?

Santa Claus Fine, thank you. A Merry Christmas to you all.

Elf Five A Merry Christmas? It's January 2nd!

Santa Claus What? Oh dear, what a long sleep I've had!

Elf Six Yes, Santa. After all that work and after your long trip around the

And look at my beard! Maybe I should cut it off.

Elf Seven We've got a whole year to get you into shape<sup>®</sup>, Santa. But we can start today with your beard.

Santa Claus That's a good idea. Let's shave it off!

Elf Eight We'll make a fit, dynamic, modern Santa Claus of you in no time.

Santa Claus Okay, let's go!

(Elf 9 brings in a tray of shaving things.)

Elf Five Here we go, Santa. (clicking scissors in the air) I'll cut off
