Preface to the Fourth Edition

Any book which endeavours to deal with a wide-ranging spectrum of law is particularly susceptible to changes in the law. The past four years have seen an especially heavy flow of statutes, statutory instruments and cases, which have been incorporated in the text where appropriate. I am obliged to the publishers and the printers for their co-operation in fitting in at the proof stage some amendments which occurred in December 1979 so that this edition is as up-to-date as it is possible to be. The new Government's Companies Bill 1979 is noted at the end of Chapter 4, but as it had not become law by the end of 1979, it should emerge as the Companies Act 1980. Despite its compendious title the Banking Act 1979 has changed little in this book, as the Act is largely concerned with the control of banks as organisations. The Consumer Credit Act 1974 continues to make slow and laborious progress towards full implementation: no doubt it will get there someday, for as the poet Swinburne puts it:

... even the weariest river
Winds somewhere safe to sea.

It made another move forward on 27 January 1980 when the repeal of the Moneylenders Act 1927, mentioned on page 30, came largely into force.

On a happier note, the Institute of Bankers celebrated its centenary in 1979; and unless something drastic happens, the Bills of Exchange Act should do likewise in two years' time.

As with the two preceding editions I must express my appreciation and thanks to Mr. R. McC. M. Adams, Resident Solicitor of the National Westminster Bank Limited, for his helpful comments on current developments; to Butterworth's editorial staff for their general guidance and the revision of the index and of the tables of statutes and cases; and to my one-time banking colleague in Leeds, Mrs. Angela E. Powell, for her assistance in proof-reading.

Preface to the First Edition

“A prudent man shuns hyaenas;
No banker is imprudent.
No banker fails to shun hyaenas.”

Lewis Carroll

This syllogism, or flawed logic, first caught my attention long before I commenced a career destined to fluctuate between banking and the law. The falsity of the second line is shown by the number of cases which have been decided adversely to banks, though they must be set against many millions of banking transactions which are happily and successfully concluded. The justification for this book as a new assortment of familiar topics is that it is designed to meet the tri-composite syllabus of the Institute of Bankers in its subject, Law Relating to Banking. It is hoped that the book will be of assistance to present and future bankers, as well as perhaps to other students who may be particularly interested in this aspect of the commercial scene.

The pattern of the book is based on the three Sections of the Institute syllabus, starting with a resumé of the law of contract, the bedrock of the whole subject, followed by chapters on Agency, Partnership, Companies and Bankruptcy to complete Section A. Then come four chapters covering the securities most commonly taken by banks—land, life policies, stocks and shares, and guarantees—which comprise Section B. The last five chapters deal with Section C, together with promissory notes which have been added for the sake of completeness, and include the full text of the Bills of Exchange Act 1882 and the Cheques Act 1957.

For bibliography, readers seeking the larger air on individual topics are recommended to turn to the following other Butterworth publications: Stevens' *Mercantile Law*; Cheshire and Fifoot's *Law of Contract*; Fridman's *Law of Agency*; Underhill's *Law of Partnership*; Magnus and Estrin's *Companies: Law and Practice*; Cheshire's *Modern Real Property*; and finally Paget's *Law of Banking*, to which all students of banking in the last resort are debtors.

I would like to thank Butterworth's editorial staff for their valuable

help, particularly in providing the index and the tables of cases and statutes.
