

1450–1340	Painted Sarcophagus from Hagia Triada (LM IIIA)

1300–1190	Lion Gate and Treasury of Atreus at Mycenae (LH IIIB)
1300–1180	Palace of Nestor at Pylos (LH IIIB)
1190–1075	Late Bronze Age IIIC
1190–1075	Warrior Vase from Mycenae (EH IIIC)
1075–1025	Sub-Mycenaean
1050–900	Protogeometric
1000-950	House at Lefkandi
900	Centaur from Lefkandi, Boots and Warrior Grave at Athens
