内容简介:

本书直面高考英语能力要求最高的主观题型:短文改错、阅读表达和书面表达。全书依据新课改和新高考考纲,结合现代教育心理学理论以及高中学生的学习特点,提倡"自主学习"、"精讲巧练"。

为此,全书突出以下特点:

短文改错:文章全部选自历届高考试题,再经适当修改。在确保高考试题精华的同时,突出巩固该题型的常考点和重难点。

阅读表达:文章选自高考试题和部分省市统一考试题,但对少部分问题及答案做了修改。以引导学生形成"阅读文章和问题,依据问题和文章而表达"的答题原则。

书面表达: 题目及参考文章基本来自历届高考试题。所选题目涵盖考纲要求的不同文体、不同命题方式及大部分写作话题,且重点突出了高考频率较高的文体和话题。还对部分参考文章做了适当修改,以帮助学生更好适应高考阅卷要求。

本书在编辑过程中,已通过特殊软件对相关题型做了智能分析, 再结合编者多年的教学经验,确保了全书题型特点突出,考点全面。 因此,建议学生除了"精练"以外,最好能"自主"地对所做题目归 纳总结,循环记忆,以期达到举一反三、以一当十的效果。
