Prof. Dr Guillermo Cabanellas (born 14 July 1950) obtained degrees in economics (1971) and law (1972) from the National University of Buenos Aires. He graduated as Master in Comparative Law (1975) and as Doctor of the Science of Law (1978) at the University of Illinois. Since 1977, he has taught at the University of Illinois, at the University of Miami and at the Loyola of Los Angeles Law School. He is also professor at the National University of Buenos Aires, Universidad Austral Argentina and the Universidad de San Andrés (Argentina). He is an honorary professor at the Catholic University of Arequipa, Perú. Professor Cabanellas was a member of the board of directors of the National Foreign Trade Commission of Argentina. He has also acted as General Director of Economic Legislation of the Ministry of the Economy of Argentina, and as a member of several legislative commissions. In 1981, 1982, and 1987, he was research fellow at the Max Planck Institute for Foreign and International Patent, Copyright and Competition Law, Munich.

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
