《高职考英语总复习》根据浙江省最新的高职（单考单招）招生考试说明的语法部分和题型部分内容要求，全书分为两大部分。第一部分对考纲要求掌握的语法知识进行了系统的解释，包括：“考纲要求”（明确考点）、“知识要点”（语法知识精讲）、“例题解析”（历年高职考真题，易错题，易混淆题等）和“同步精练”（课堂练习用），以期达到对基础知识全面的检查；第二部分按高职考的八种题型进行编写即语音知识、单词拼写、单项选择、完形填空、阅读理解、完成对话、短文改错、书面表达。每种题型包括“题型分解”、“方法指导”、“强化训练”。并对2013年高职考试试卷进行分析。供第一、二轮复习使用。

《高职考英语同步综合检测卷》由三部分内容组成，第一部分是结合总复习的语法项目，配备了一定量的练习，供教师阶段测试或考生课外巩固知识使用，供第一轮复习使用；第二部分是结合总复习的专题部分，配备了一定量的练习，供考生课外熟悉高职考题型使用；第三部分是配备少量的模拟卷，使考生对高职考试卷有初步的认识，供第二轮复习使用。

《高职考英语最后冲刺模拟卷》根据浙江省2014年高职英语考试大纲编写了16套测试卷和解题思路分析及答案，供第三轮复习使用。

由于时间仓促，书中错漏和不妥之处在所难免，恳请广大读者批评指正，以利于改进和提高。
