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前 言

教育部颁布的《高职高专教育英语课程教学基本要求（试行）》明确指出：高职高专院校应把高等学校英语应用能力考试 A 级作为学生达标要求，B 级为过渡性要求。A、B 级考试自 2014 年 12 月起已正式改革，采用新题型，最大的变化是听力理解比例增加，难度增加。为了帮助考生进一步熟悉新题型的内容及难度，顺利通过考试，我们精心策划并编写了此书。本书是根据国家教育部高等教育司颁布的《高职高专英语课程基本要求》和《高等学校英语应用能力考试大纲（2014 年新大纲）》的要求编写而成的，适用于参加全国高等学校英语应用能力 A、B 级考试的所有考生。

本书有以下特点：

（1）紧扣考纲、针对性强：本书的试卷内容、难易程度、覆盖面和试卷质量严格按照高等学校英语应用能力考试大纲（2014 年新大纲）编写，以帮助考生在最短的时间内掌握最新考试题型和解题技巧。

（2）选题新颖、实用性强：本书分别收录了 4 套最新的 A 级和 B 级实考试题及其录音原声，使考生能够了解有关考试的最新、最准确的信息和动向。另外还分别精选了 4 套 A 级和 B 级模拟试题，供考生考前自测。考生使用本书进行复习训练有助于提高 A、B 级考试的通过率，并有助于学习者掌握英语的实际应用本领，提高其语言交际能力。

本书是编者在长期研究高等学校英语应用能力 A、B 级考试的基础上编写的。我们诚挚地希望广大读者对本书提出宝贵意见。
