PREFACE

There are three main purposes of this book: (1) to aid the busy ophthalmologist in identifying all ocular manifestations of a given syndrome or disease; (2) to provide references so that the ophthalmologist will know where to look for additional information; and (3) to promote greater observance of the characteristics of ocular syndromes and systemic diseases. This book is designed for quick reference while the patient's eyes are being dilated or immediately following an examination. Practicality is the objective; conciseness, logical arrangement, and authenticity the main features.

I have endeavored to include all systemic syndromes and diseases that have ocular manifestations. The titles are arranged alphabetically. A general definition, clinical ocular findings, clinical systemic findings, and several references are included for each entry. Each entity is dealt with as completely as space and practicality allow. Laboratory findings have not been considered, since the book is designed to serve as the ophthalmologist's primary aid for information. If any syndromes or systemic diseases with ocular manifestations have been omitted, I urge you to inform me of this so that any future editions of the book may include them.

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
