

Her research interests include phenomenology, genealogy, and critical theory, especially as these are applied to gender, political economy, demography, and the body. She is currently completing a study on the population question funded by a three-year Leverhulme Fellowship.

Elisabeth Ellis is Associate Professor of Philosophy at the University of Otago. She is the author of *Provisional Politics: Kantian Arguments in Policy Context* (2008) and *Kant's Politics: Provisional Theory for an Uncertain World* (2005); she has also edited a volume of essays, *Kant's Political Theory: Interpretations and Applications* (2012). Ellis's current book project, *Extinction and Democracy*, asks whether democratic practices and species conservation are compatible. Other recent projects include a reception history of Hobbes's political thought and an assessment of the challenges environmental policy poses for democratic theory. She is currently serving as copresident of the Association for Political Theory.

Kennan Ferguson teaches political theory at the University of Wisconsin, Milwaukee. He is author of *All in the Family: On Community and Incommensurability* (2012), William James: Politics in the Pluriverse (2007), and The Politics of Judgment (1999). He also chairs the Foundations of Political Theory section of the American Political Science Association and coedits, with Morton Schoolman, the Rowman and Littlefield series Modernity and Political Thought.
