如何让你的演讲出类拔萃,让在场听众为之折服? Professor Susan Chyn,美国教育考试中心亚太区主管为演讲爱好者传授金玉良言。

Number one: read texts that represent a high level of discourse; soak up that language. But, remember that written text has a discourse that is separate from spoken discourse. Some of you were speaking today in very, kind of written-prose language, and you may not want to do that in the future.

Number two piece of advice: make a tape recording of yourself talking about abstract topics or complex topics then go back and listen to it and listen to how it sounds; if it's cohesive and coherent? are there errors? Then go back, practice again, and do it a second time like editing a written text but, in fact, it's a spoken text. You will hear what you're doing that could be improved, even you, and of course if you have teachers, that's even better, but you, yourself will hear.

Finally, my last piece of advice for you is that you should practice building; if language, if spoken language was like a house you should practice building the house brick by brick, storey by storey so you can all do basic sentences now, clearly. And, most of you are pretty good at building paragraphs, but some of you are not yet perfect house builders in terms of discourse and organization skills so you want to practice writing compound and complex sentences, and then weave those together into paragraphs and you'll weave those paragraphs into the full spoken text. Weave them together,

push yourself to go for the discourse and woven nature so that not only the thought flows, but it's coherent. And, I think you'll agree with me, that some of the most compelling speeches we heard today displayed this coherent and sort of natural progression of ideas. If you do that, there's no doubt in my mind that you can progress at this area.

In conclusion, I would like to quote one of our question masters, who said today that, "Life is a journey, not the arrival, that you focus on the journey not the arrival." Language learning is lifelong, lifelong. So, as you move forward, language learning enjoy the journey and I look forward to seeing you again.

第一点建议,看那些有着很有条理性的文章,把语言学到手。但要记住, 书面文稿和演讲稿有着不一样的条理和结构。你们当中有些人用书面语言来 演讲,以后就不要这样了。

第二点建议,说一段抽象或复杂的题目,把它录下来,然后听听说得怎么样。说得有条理吗?说错了吗?然后再练习一次,在录第二次的时候就像是在整理书面文稿,但事实上这是个演讲稿。你可以看到这样做是可以提高你的英语水平的。当然,如果有老师在旁指点就更好了。但你自己也会发现这些讲步。

最后,我给你们最后的建议就是你要学会建造。如果口语是一座房屋,你就要学习用一块块砖、一层层地把它建起来。所以,现在你们就可以从最简单的句子开始学起。你们当中的大部分人很会建段落,但有些人在条理性和组织性方面欠缺,还不是很出色的房屋建造者。所以你们要练习写些复合句,将它们连成段落,再把这些段落连成完整的演讲稿。把它们串起来,强迫自己写得有条理和连贯,这样不单可以令文思源源不绝,文章也会很连贯。还有,我想你们也会赞同的,今天我们听到的一些最精彩的演讲表现了连贯性和意思上自然的过渡。如果你们能按照我刚才说的方法去做,我敢肯定你们在这方面会大有进步的。

最后我想引用一个发问人说的话来结束评论。他说"人生是旅程,而不是目的地。你要重视旅程而不是目的地。"学习语言是要用一辈子的。所以,当你往前走的时候,希望你享受学习语言的过程。


This is the 8th time that *China Daily* has organized this contest. We hope it will be a good opportunity for the participants to display their talents in language and public speaking and to exchange ideas on important current issues. We also hope that you, the audience, will enjoy this exciting competition and benefit from what you hear.

The scale of our competition has always been expanding. About 500 students from more than 300 universities around China took part in the first round of this competition last October. After regional contests in east, west, south, and north China, the top two winners from each region now come to today's final competition to compete with contestants from our seed universities.

There are all together twenty-four contestants from university around China to compete in today's English speaking competition.

Ladies and gentlemen, this competition will be mediated by a panel of seven judges. The panel includes experts on communications and on English language teaching and learning. Also on the panel are three "question masters" who will be responsible for raising questions of today's contestants. Now, let's go over the rules of the competition.

Each of the contestants have 5 minutes to present a prepared speech, 3 minutes to deliver an impromptu speech, and



Well, that's because the international public speaking will be held this May, and the organizer, the English Speaking Union, requires all participants to be under the age of 21.





#### A Scene to Remember

Good afternoon, ladies and gentlemen. Today I would like to begin with a story.

There was once a physical <sup>1)</sup>therapist who traveled all the way from America to Africa to do a <sup>2)</sup>census about mountain <sup>3)</sup>gorillas. These gorillas are a main attraction to tourists from all over the world; this put them severely under threat of <sup>4)</sup>poaching and being put into the zoo. She went there out of curiosity, but what she saw strengthened her determination to devote her whole life to fighting for those beautiful creatures. She witnessed a scene, a scene taking us to a place we never imaged we've ever been, where in the very depth of the African rainforest, surrounded by trees, flowers and butterflies, the mother gorillas <sup>5)</sup>cuddled their babies.

Yes, that's a memorable scene in one of my favorite movies, called *Gorillas in the Mist*, based on a true story of Mrs. Dian Fossey, who spent most of her lifetime in Rwanda to protect the ecoenvironment there until the very end of her life.

To me, the movie not only presents an unforgettable scene but also acts as a <sup>6</sup> timeless reminder that we should
