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前言

本书系根据由高等学校英语专业教学大纲词汇表工作组最新编写的、上海外语教育出版社于2001年7月出版的《高等学校英语专业全程通用词汇表》和《高等学校英语专业基础阶段英语教学大纲》编写而成。

随着英语专业水平考试的普及,专业四级考试越来越受到广大师生的重视。作为一个评价教与学的客观尺度,英语专业四级考试对于基础阶段的学生来讲,的确有一定的难度。众所周知,通过专业四级考试需要有较高的语言综合运用能力,但其基础是词汇的掌握和运用。听力、阅读、翻译和写作都离不开词汇,记单词、扩大词汇量是准备专业四级考试的first priority。

但同时,词汇学习又往往是大家最头痛的事情!几乎每个英语学习者、每个想参加英语考试的人都在背单词,都希望在最短的时间内掌握所有的词汇,可许多人随便抱起一本词汇书,就开始狂背数遍:词条、音标、词性、中文释义、第二个释义、第三个……,但结果往往事与愿违,当时似乎全都记住了,到真正进考场时,真正看到文章时,满眼都是熟悉的单词,但却往往不知所云,更休谈做题了。

因此,广大考生和英语学习者都迫切呼唤有一本能够真正帮助他们记住单词、掌握每个单词微言大义的词汇书。为满足英语专业四级考生的需要,我们根据四级考试大纲的要求和近年来四级考试的全真试题,精心编写了本书。

本书具备以下特点:

英汉双解、加深理解 在编写过程中,我们借鉴朗 文词典的做法,用最简单的语言(词汇量不超过2000) 给大多数单词都加上详细的英文解释,以便读者更深刻 地掌握单词的确切含义,使这些词条变得前所未有地清 晰、易懂!这样,英语专业的学生不仅可以加深对单词 的记忆,还可以通过准确权威的英语解释体会许多近义 词之间的细微差别!

真题巩固、目标明确 在考试重点词汇的词条解释中,我们加入了来自1993年到2003年专业四级考试真题中多项选择题和阅读理解中的原题和句子,通过例句、真题帮助考生对专四考试所考查的知识点有一个全方位的了解,并复习巩固对词条的记忆。此外,我们对每道题进行了精确到位的分析,不仅使读者能知其然,还能知其所以然!

内容全面、突出考点 本书在大纲词表内容的基础上,着重解释单词的各种用法、搭配关系、句型结构、固定短语和与之相关的词义辨析,还给出了常用的同义词、反义词、派生词。同时,在内容丰富的基础上,本书内容力求紧密结合考试、紧扣单词的要害之处进行讲解,使读者能够迅速学以致用,实用价值显著。

经全体编著者的数月劳作,书稿初成;又经John Mason先生反复审校,成书才得以呈现于此。如本书能对考生通过英语专业四级考试有所助益,亦足慰辛劳。但因我们水平有限,书中疏漏之处在所难免,望广大读者不吝批评指正!
