林亦香,1940年生於日本橫濱。1953年隨父田回國。1965年 畢業於浙江美術學院版畵系。現為杭州畵院高級畵師、中國美術家 協會會員、中國版畵家協會會員、浙江省美協理事、杭州市美協常 務理事。其作品多次参加全國美展、被國家博物館収藏、編入《中國 女版畵家作品選》、並送日本、新加坡、西德等國展出。簡歷和作品 已収入《中國現代美術家人名大辭典》。經過二十多年的藝術實踐,逐漸形成自已獨立的藝術風格。作品優雅、精致、獨特、單純中不失 豐富,寂靜中蘊涵生機。近年來從中國漢代石刻拓片藝術中吸取養 料,豐富自已的版畵計言。在創造旣具民族傳統又融入現代意識的 作品方面取得可喜的成就。

Lin Yixiang. Born in Yokohama, Japan in 1940 and returned with her parents to China in 1953; graduated from the department of woodcuts, the Zhejiang Academy of Fine Arts. A senior painter at the Hangzhou Academy of Painting, member of the Chinese Artists' Association and the Chinese Graphic Artists' Associa-

ation, council member of the Zhejiang Art Association and the Hangzhou Art Association.

Her works made frequent appearances in national art exhibitions. Some of them are collected by the national art gallery; some compiled into *A Selection from Chinese Women Engravers' Woodcuts* and some exhibited in Japan, Singapore and Germany. She is also listed in the *Contemporary Chinese Artists' Who's Who*. After years of hard work, she has gradually formed her unique style — elegant, delicate, simple but not monotonous, tranquil and full of vigor. In recent years, in order to flourish her techniques, she has concentrated on the study of stone tablet inscriptions of the Han Dynasty (206 B.C.–220 A.D.) and made favorable achievements in creating works that embody both traditional and modern ideas.








