

《美国之音电视英语新闻精选》前宫

听力课是英语专业的基础课程,通常排在听、说、读、写、译五项能力培训之首。"美国之音"新闻广播是英语听力训练的重要内容。早在1988年,原国家教委就在其《高等学校英语专业基础阶段和高年级阶段教学大纲》中就明确规定,要把能够基本听懂"美国之音"的新闻广播作为衡量英语听力能力的一项重要指标。我们编写这套教材的目的是为了帮助广大学生和英语爱好者熟悉和掌握"美国之音"的主要内容和基本形式,对其听懂英语原文广播进行专门的技能培养,并以此为突破口、全面提高英语学习者的听力水平。

本教材以书、VCD 为载体、编者创造性地为"美国之音"语言广播配制了电视画面,使学习者不仅能听其"言",而且能观其"形",大大提高了教材的趣味性和使用价值。内容涉及政治、外交、军事、突发事件等。教材编排合理有序,每条新闻设有注释(含生词、短语、背景知识)、练习、答案、原文、译文等项目,既可供课堂听力教学,也便于自学者使用。

本教材在编写过程中得到了上海外语音像出版社孟庆和社长和陈坚林总编的热情支持,吴畏编辑为此教材的出版付出了艰辛的劳动。在此一并致谢。
