## 前言

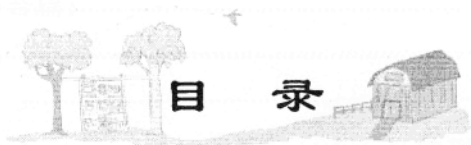
