

前言

大学英语教学的目的主要是让学生掌握一定的英语语言知识并运用这些知识灵活地进行各种形式的交际活动,解决各种实际问题。目前,在大学中统一进行的四级考试则是试图对这种教学目的实现情况进行检查而采用的一种手段,在要求与程度上具有某种强制性。不过,这并不可怕,问题在于要能找到事半功倍的学习方法与针对性、实用性较强的学习或复习用书。笔者正是从这一角度出发精心编写了本书。

本书的特点是依据外语教育学与心理学理论,融调查研究于一体。目的在于努力培养考生良好的心理素质,围绕"突破"二字,向考生交答题解疑的钥匙,使之学得轻松而踏实,同时义能运用所掌握的应试技巧、方法与规律,达到举一反三、触类旁通、增强临场应变能力的目的。

本书是一本词汇与语法的练习题集,其内容基本上涵盖了大学英语四级考试中词汇与语法的重点与难点。适于参加全国大学英语四级水平考试的学生与其他具有较高水平的英语学习者使用,也适于教师在教学中参考使用。
