





Dear George,

I should be grateful if you would bring the following matter to the attention of the proper quarters:

You may recall that the Japanese ship, Lisbon Maru, transporting 2,000 British Prisoners of War from Hong Kong to Japan, was sunk by a submarine on the 2nd October, 1942, near the Chusan Archipelago. Approximately 200 survivors were rescued from the sea by the Chinese people of East Fisherman Island, and were cared for on the evening of the 2nd and the morning of the 3rd October. Had this not been done many of them would have drowned or been dashed to death on the rocks by the heavy seas pounding the cliffs.

The survivors were fed, clothed and tended with the greatest kindness by these Chinese islanders, but, on the morning of the 3rd, it was evident that the food on the island was insufficient to keep them alive and all but three of them gave themselves up to the Japanese who landed on the island from a warship.

The three who did not give themselves up were aided by the Chinese to escape to Allied lands. In the course of their escape they were hidden and aided by islanders at imminent risk of their lives.

In recognition of this generous and courageous service the British Government have granted a sum of money to be paid to the islanders, and the Commander-in-chief proposes, should the Chinese Government see no objection, that His Majesty's Ship Comus should visit East Fisherman Island on the 7th May to carry out an official presentation of these monetary awards. On completion of the ceremony His Majesty's Ship Comus would proceed to Shanghai, arriving on the 9th May and staying until the 17th May.

His Majesty's Ship Comus is a modern destroyer No. R.43 commanded by Lieutenant Commander Evans. She carries no aircraft.

I shall be glad to hear from you in due course whether the Chinese Government are, as I hope, agreeable to this proposal.
