说 明

小学英语 (PEP) 同步系列读物 *Read Me* 是依据国家《九年义务教育英语课程标准 (实验稿)》的一、二级语言技能中对阅读能力的要求编写的, 配合人民教育出版社出版的“(PEP) PRIMARY ENGLISH”教材, 并与该教材单元教学同步使用。本读物以单元的话题为主题, 在单元学习的基础上, 以不同形式和题材扩大学生阅读量和学习视野, 并让他们从中获得乐趣, 达到培养和发展学生初步的阅读技能的目的。训练的形式包括帮助学生预测阅读内容, 理解阅读材料大意, 读懂简单的细节以及理解文中的指代等。本书从五年级开始编写, 每学期一册, 共四册。

本书共有六个阅读话题: “This Is My Day”, “My Favourite Season”, “My Birthday”, “What Are You Doing?” “Look at the Monkeys” 和 “A Field Trip”。本读物体裁多样, 包括配图说明、短文、故事、诗歌、图表、标示等。每单元分三部分: 第一部分: Topic time。这是课文的话题的扩充内容, 如文化背景知识、生活常识等, 并配有一些简单的阅读理解练习。第二部分: Story time。这是与话题有关的一个幽默故事, 其中有些故事的主要人物就是课本中的 Zip 和 Zoom。第三部分: Fun time。这是与话题相关的配图诗歌、谜语、笑话、游戏说明、绕口令、图片等, 读起来让人感到轻松、愉悦。

参加本书编写的人员有: 谢李莉、黄咏珩、徐永红、许瑞芬, 全书由唐锡玲审阅。由于本书编写仓促, 编写形式也是一种新的尝试, 希望读者能提出意见和建议, 以便进一步完善。

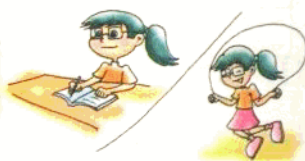
This Is My Day

Part 1 Topic time

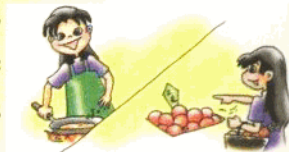
I. Try to read

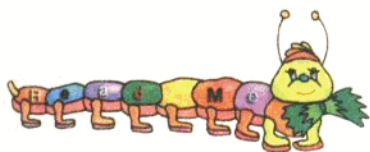

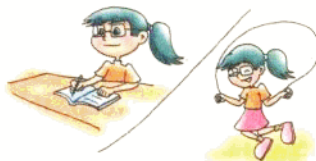

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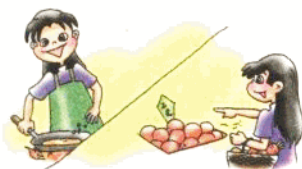

Zip: It is bright 24 hours a day, even after the sun sets.

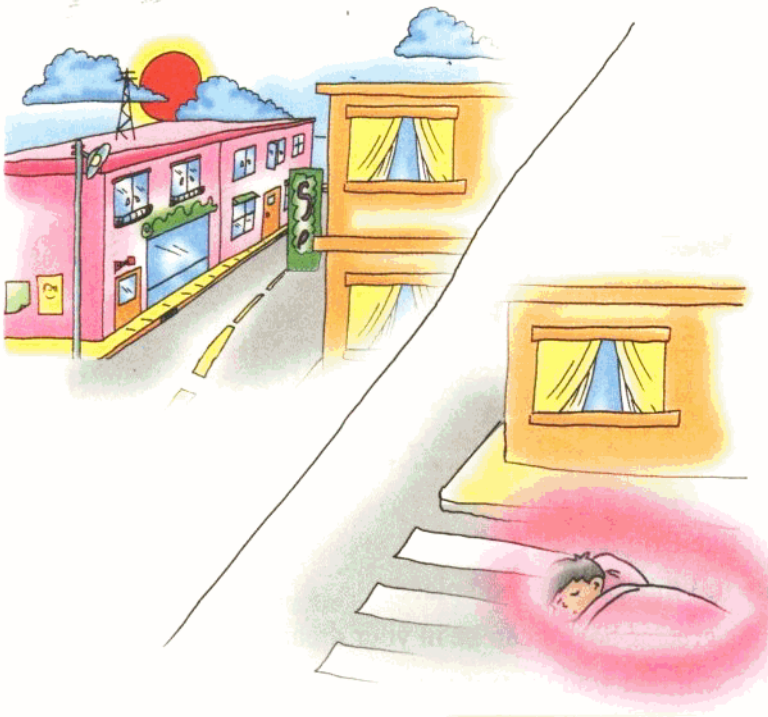
Zoom: Wow! When do people go to bed? Do they sleep?

Zoom: I see. But what do they do after they get up in the evening? Can they see anything?

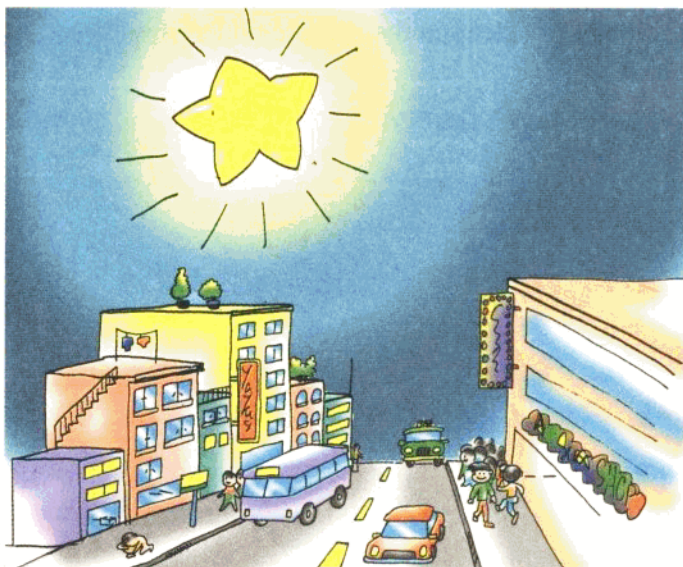
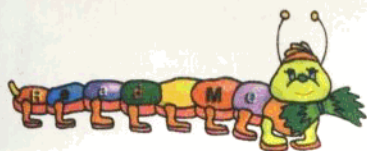
Zip: The star comes out and shines brightly. It is as bright as in the daytime.

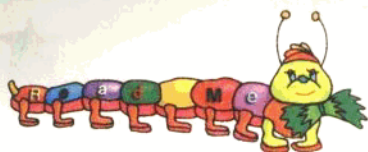
One of My Days
