本书是上海市前进进修学院 TOEFL 班的指定教材中的《结构及书面表达》部分,由在该院执教 TOEFL 多年的资深教授编写而成。全书共分三个部分。第一部分为分类练习,共选 1000 题;第二部分为试题汇编;第三部分为第一部分和第二部分的答案。本书内容丰富,选题广泛,既可作课堂教材,又可供自学使用。本书对准备参加 TOEFL 的考生了解近年来 TOEFL《结构及书面表达》部分的题型及思路,对提高应试能力定能有所裨益。

前 言

近年来,随着我国学生英语水平的普遍提高,参加国际性和国内统一英语语言能力考试已成为不少学生检阅自己学习成绩、准备出国深造或加盟国内外商投资企业的一个重要手段。

主语是句子的一个主要成分。除某些特殊情况(如祈使句中通常没有主语等)外,这一成分是不可缺少的。倘若句中没有主语,应填入空白部分的,就该考虑是这一成分。可作主语的通常有:名词、代词、数词、动名词、不定式和从句等。有些形容词前加一定冠词也可作主语。以不定式、动名词等短语或以从句作主语时,如果主语较长,也可将其置于句子后部,而以形式主语 *it* 置于句首。有时在 4 项选择中,不止一项可作主语,则需考虑逻辑主语是否正确;主、谓语在“数”上是否一致;以及主、谓语应否倒装等问题;而选择正确的一项。例:

(二) 谓语

谓语也是句子中的一个主要成分,通常是必不可少的。如果题中缺少谓语,那么应选择的必然是带有谓语动词的一项。倘若4项选择中只有一项带有谓语动词,通常该项即为正确的一项。如果选

择答案中不止一项含有谓语动词,则需注意该动词在“人称”和“数”上是否和主语一致,同时还需考虑它的时态、语态和语气等各个方面。由 there 引起的句子中,主语通常置于谓语后面。例:
