主语是句子的一个主要成分。除某些特殊情况(如祈使句中通常没有主语等)外,这一成分是不可缺少的。倘若句中没有主语,应填入空白部分的,就该考虑是这一成分。可作主语的通常有:名词、代词、数词、动名词、不定式和从句等。有些形容词前加一定冠词也可作主语。以不定式、动名词等短语或以从句作主语时,如果主语较长,也可将其置于句子后部,而以形式主语,正置于句首。有时在4项选择中,不止一项可作主语,则需考虑逻辑主语是否正确;主、谓语在"数"上是否一致;以及主、谓语应否倒装等问题;而选择正确的一项。例:
