

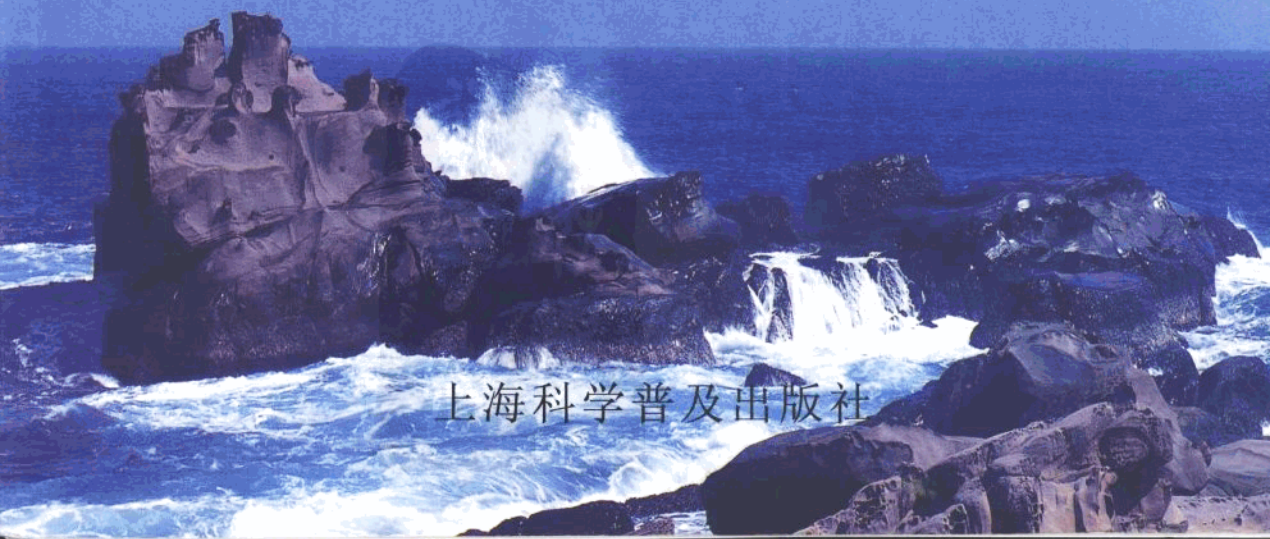

前 言

为了顺应广大中职校师生的要求，帮助他们准确把握新教材的重点和难点，提高教与学的水平，我们组织了众多国家级重点学校的英语教研组长和一线骨干教师编写了《上海市中等职业学校英语新编教材巩固与拓展》一书。

本书的编写适应了新学年的教学和考试要求，具有非常鲜明的特点：

- 一、 兼顾两套教材。“一考两证”和教学检查是以“课程标准”为依据，兼顾两套教材，本书巧妙地迎合了这一特点。以华师大版的每两课和上外版的一个单元设置一套同步测试题。每套测试题中的 Test One 部分根据不同版本分别编写；Test Two 为能力题，综合两本教材的重点词汇、语法和语言功能编写而成，但所考查的知识点又以“课程标准”为依托，不考超纲的偏词、难词。
- 二、 紧密联系课文。本书共有十套同步测试题，同时编有期中、期末试题。内容编排与教材同步，不随意拔高与超前。练习题既紧扣课文，又注重知识点的横向联系。
- 三、 难度切合实际。试题难度立足现有中职学生的实际水平，并兼顾中专、职校、技校的教学差异。
- 四、 题型紧扣考纲。模拟题题型、难度与“一考两证”和教学检查保持一致。
- 五、 主客观题并存。Test One 是主观题，供学生操练本单元应掌握的重点词汇、句型和语法，Test Two 是客观题，考查学生的英语综合运用能力。

为了保证教学效果，本书习题答案另行装订，并配有听力磁带，与书同步发行。由于编者水平有限，加之时间仓促，书中难免差错，恳请广大师生批评指正。
