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## 前 言

为方便考生自我复习，本书对语法结构与词汇、完形填空这两种题型中的每个习题的答案都作了简要的注释。本书短文写作部分对每个作文题都提供了范文供考生参考。

与这套习题配合，我们另编六套模拟试题，于今年10月出版。届时该模拟试题将综合最新考试动态和考试要求编写。

本书编者全部都是北京大学英语系教师，都有多年研究生入学英语考试的辅导和命题经验。

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# 第一部分 综合练习题

语法填空题测试考生对英语语法(词法和句法)基本知识掌握的情况。本部分试题涉及到常见的多种语法现象和语法规则。语法填空题考查的语法知识主要包括:

#### 3. 虚拟语气

例如 1994—No.7: The millions of calculations involved, had they been done by hand, \_\_\_\_\_ all practical value by the time they were finished.

## 二、语法辨错

### (一) 概述

语法辨错试题考查考生根据英语语法基本知识辨别病句中词语用法错误或句子结构错误的能力。除了涉及语法填空部分所提到的语法知识外，语法辨错试题还涉及以下几方面的语法知识：

#### 1. 主语和谓语动词在人称和数方面的一致关系

例如 1994-No.17. The weeds and tall grass in that yard makes the house

look as if it had been vacant for quite some time.

B错，应改为 make。本句主语 the weeds and tall grass 是复数，不是第三人称单数，谓动词 make 不能加“s”。

## 2、其它各类前后一致性的问题

例如 1993—No. 69: It is required by law that a husband have to pay the debts of his wife until formal notice is given that he no longer has to pay her.

## 3、形容词和副词的用法
