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前 言

随着中国改革开放的不断深入,英语已成为人们对外交流的重要工具。“听、说、读、写、译”是学习英语的几个基本功,而“听”被排为第一,由此可见其在语言学习中的重要地位。不少学生反映,学了好几年英语,可仍然无法与外国人交流。因此,如何使学生在较短的时间内,较快地提高听力水平是我们编写本教材的初衷。

这套教材,可供中专学校、职业技术学院的在校生及成人非英语专业的专科生及英语爱好者使用。

这套教材含学生用书、教师用书及配套光盘。

学生用书共分三册,前两册以日常生活为题材,从学生熟悉的身边事开始,循序渐进,以培养学生的综合听力水平。第三册中的商贸英语,重点对学生进行岗位训练;求职应试英语,旨在帮助学生顺利求职,轻松通过面试。

教师用书第一册,内容包括:听力材料的全文及练习、参考答案,必要的注解以及某些专业知识介绍,这主要是为那些非贸易专业学生进行讲解时使用,教师可根据情况进行取舍。

配套光盘包括全部课文和练习所要求的录音,由外籍教师按顺序录制。

教材中的口语练习部分是为了给学生提供一个与课文所学内容相关的训练素材,教师可根据学生的情况来安排教学时间。
