- 1. 选B。本文从头至尾都没提到这个谎话是什么,即B选项是正确答案。而根据第1段句子"But one day I told him a lie. I cannot tell you now what the lie was.可知,这个男孩撒了谎。祖父知道这个男孩撒了谎,没有直接点明,而是在看书时叫人搬来一把梯子。在故事的最后,祖父和男孩都笑了。因此,A,C,D都可以在短文中找到答案。
- 2. 选A。词语要放在句子当中来猜测它的意思。原句是"Grandfather was not cross with me."而短文没有说祖父对我生气,选项出现了surprised(吃惊的)、happy (开心的)、kind (慈善的),显然不合句子意思,而be cross with sb与be angry with sb同义。
- 3. 选C。第4段说到"I knew at once what he was telling me..."从这里知道祖父叫人搬来梯子的用意,就是让这个男孩知道撒谎是不对的。
- 4. 选A。根据第4段的句子 "A lie is a jump from the top of a house"可知,别人都知道梯子意味着有人撒谎了。所以作者的担心就很容易理解了,即作者害怕别人都知道他撒谎了。
- 5. 选A。短文中的句子 "Grandfather seemed very happy once again." 和"His words made me happy again."说明故事的结尾是enjoyable(开心的)。

- 1. 选A。根据第2段的句子"He sadly walked away and thought how..."中的walked一词就可判断Tom经过商店时是on foot。
- 2. 选B。第1段说到"...and he felt happy to see that the pair of shoes he wanted very much was still there."从这里可以看出,Tom在商店前停下是想look at the shoes he liked(看看他喜欢的鞋)。
- 3. 选C。第1段说到,Tom很欣喜地看到他喜欢的鞋子was still there,也就是说鞋子was not sold yet(还没卖出去)。
- 4. 选D。第2段说"He decided not to go home at once, as he looked sad and his mother would notice it."于是他就去了公园。所以从这里可以知道,他去公园是为了不让他妈妈担忧。
