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前 言

《大学英语自主听力教程》是根据教育部 2007 年颁布的《大学英语课程教学要求》中“一般要求”中英语听力能力要求编写的,主要具有如下特色:

1. 以话题为单位的模块化特色,突出学习的自主性

本套教材按照 topic-based 原则编写,主题构成基本涵盖了《大学英语课程教学要求》所要求的学习目标:日常生活、工作、社会交往等常见话题。每个主题既相对独立,又与听力技能有所联系。学生可以根据自身情况,自主选择学习内容,灵活安排学习进程。

2. 学练结合,突出学习的针对性

本套教材内容丰富,语言规范,题材广泛,题型新颖,旨在帮助学生掌握解题技巧。通过对每种题型的分项练习,再以模拟题的形式对听力技巧和听力能力加以巩固。在听力应试技巧方面,本教材针对大学英语四级、六级考试大纲中设计的听力短对话、长对话、短文和复合式听写四部分进行了重点指导,归纳特点,学生既可以有效、快捷地掌握听力应试技巧,又能迅速地提高英语听力能力。

3. 听说结合,突出学习的实用性

本套教材不仅为学生提供了大量的听力原文材料,同时还根据不同的主题为学生归纳整理了与之相关的常见词汇和句型。本教材不仅适用于学生英语听力自主学习和训练,同时还适用于学生日常口语交际练习。

4. 寓教于乐,突出学习的趣味性

本套教材除了常见的听力技能训练外,还设计了“休闲听力”板块,该板块由英文故事、英文歌曲、英文经典电影对白等剪辑构成,既保证了教材的实效性,又强调了学习的趣味性,旨在培养学生学习、体验、欣赏英语和了解英美文化的能力。

5. 难度由浅入深,循序渐进,突出学习的易学性

考虑到当前一般本科院校学生的实际情况,本套教材从语音入手,以绕口

令的形式训练学生的语音和语调。每个交际话题按照短对话、长对话、短文和复合式听写四种形式螺旋式展开,突出了学习的易学性。

6. 适用范围广,实用性强,实效性高

本套教材适用于本科院校非英语专业学生和英语专业学生,也适用于各类高等院校学生。由于附有全部录音原文和参考答案,本套教材非常适合于英语听力自主学习和训练,同时适合于校园调频电台播放和自主学习中心使用。

本套教材共分两册,上册主要侧重于听力基础技能的训练,供一年级学生使用;下册主要侧重于听力综合技能的训练,供二年级学生使用。通过完成本套教材的学习,学生能达到《大学英语课程教学要求》中“一般要求”所规定的英语听力水平。

本套教材由重庆科技学院“国家精品课程”《基础英语》主持人刘寅齐教授担任总主编,主研人全冬担任上册主编,主研人张琪担任下册主编,编者均系多年从事大学英语教学的一线教师,他们具有丰富的教学经验。

本套教材是我们在加强大学生英语自主听力指导方面所尝试的一次改革,其中难免会存在不足之处,敬请使用者批评指正。

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
